- 1. All ridden horses and ponies to be four years old and over.
- 2. Hats to a minimum standard of PAS 015 to be worn at all times when mounted with chinstraps correctly and securely fastened. Competitors are advised to use body protectors.
- 3. The judge's decision is final.
- 4. Ages attained on the day of the show.
- 5. Any objection is to be lodged at the secretary's office within 15 minutes of the Class ending together with a deposit of £25.00. This is refundable only in the event of the objection being upheld.
- 6. Neither the organisers nor any person acting on their behalf, accept any liability for any loss, damage, injury or illness to persons, animals, vehicles or property.
- 7. Every effort has been made when planning this schedule to arrange classes in such a way as to avoid clashes. The stewards and officials will be sympathetic with anyone who finds themselves in difficulties, but the organisers cannot undertake to delay any class unduly, or refund entry money if a class is missed.
- 8. Dogs must be kept on leads at all times.
- 9. The organisers reserve the right to refuse an entry or to modify the schedule at any time.
- 10. Please be polite to stewards and officials at all times. Anyone being abusive will be asked to leave the showground. Any entry fees paid will not be refunded.

It shall be expected that full compliance is offered by all attendees and it shall be the right of the organisers to ask persons not agreeing to comply to leave the premises.
