FUN EVENT CLASSES:

1. ***PRE NOVICE ODE** *May be led / accompanied – over a shortened Cross Country. For the young, genuinely inexperienced or real equine veterans. If you can canter & jump on your own please enter Novice Section.*
 - **Dressage:** Canter 2019 free test 10 – see website for test
 - **Jumping:** 18”
 - **short X-C’try:** up to 18”
2. **NOVICE ODE**
For those who have not placed in the top 3 more than 3 times at 2’3 or below in any jumping competition including cross country.
 - **Dressage:** DHS 2019 Test 11 – see website for test.
 - **Jumping:** 2’3”
 - **X-C’try:** max 2’3” average 2”
3. **INTERMEDIATE ODE** *starting 1.30pm*
 - **Dressage:** DHS 2019 Test 12 – see website for test
 - **Jumping:** 2’6”
 - **X-C’try:** max 2’6”
4. **OPEN ODE**
 - **Dressage:** DHS 2019 Test 12 – see website for test
 - **Jumping:** 2’9”
 - **X-C’try:** max 2’9

if there are sufficient time slots you may enter only Dressage or only Jumping for any class. See Entry fee for details.

ENTRY FORMS Can be downloaded from our website:- www.denmeadhorseshow.co.uk or you can make out your own on a blank piece of paper being sure to include the following information :

- Competitor name & contact details (telephone, email, address) + age if under 18 – Parents must sign for minors.
- The HORSE’s name, age, height, breed & colour.
- **The Classes you wish to enter**
- **Vehicle Registration Number for your vehicle pass together with Driver details**
- Contact details for any other permitted person (groom/trainer/parent) with you (this is in case they are needed for track and trace. This information will be shredded (deleted) after a month if it has not been needed.
- A signed statement that you have read, accept and will abide by all the rules and wish us to make use of the information for show purposes. This information is for administrative purposes only and will not be passed on to third parties. **Entries that do NOT contain the above will be rejected**
- **Please make out a separate entry form for each competitor**

2021 FUN EVENT FORMAT

Upon receipt of entry you will be sent /emailed a confirmation, number and vehicle pass. Your times will be published / emailed to you on the Tuesday before the Event. This will give you a working in time and dressage time. The other sections will follow straight on.

In order to comply with current social distancing **criteria you may only unbox / leave your parking space at your given 'working in' time.** After you finish your round you must return to box park and leave as soon as you can having cooled / untacked, etc

At commencement please report to the relevant Marshal at the working in area.

Dress Code. for this year only Competitors should complete the entire competition in their Cross Country colours including the dressage phase. Riders may choose whether to wear the body protectors for the entire competition or whether to add their body protector on top after the dressage phase. The only change to tack is the addition of Boots after the dressage phase in the holding box by your groom.

Show Jumping. Instead of the normal break between phases to allow competitors to go and do a separate clear round jumping option to get their horses jumping, the show jumping phase will consist of 2 rounds. The best score will count towards your overall score. If you achieve a clear round in your first round you will also receive a clear round rosette with your results pack.

Cross Country. It is almost impossible to get eliminated in this fun format. This will only happen if you or your horse are deemed unfit or dangerous to carry on.

Jumping Scores are marked on what you achieve rather than penalties – if you do not like a fence leave it out and carry on! **After 3 attempts at any one fence you MUST move on** This applies to both jumping phases.

Time allowed is generous so there is no need to hurry but marks will be taken off for excessive time taken. The 2 jumping phases are against the clock but time taken will only count if the scores are equal.

There will be NO Prize Giving for 2021. Instead all scores /placings will be calculated at the end of the day and published on our Facebook page. Score sheets and rosettes will be placed into the post by the end of the week.

Entry Must be Prebooked and paid either by email / BACS or by Post

ENTRY FEE: £25

JUMPING PHASES only: £15 please put a J on your entry form next to the class number.

DRESSAGE only: £10 please put a D on your entry form next to the class number.

Course Walks on Saturday by appointment – please book a time slot.

All competitors are asked to leave a Large stamped address envelope with the Secretary in order to forward their result pack. Please forgive us if there is a slight delay before they are put in the post but we only have 3 days to take the entire course down and remove it from the site!

RULES & CONDITIONS

This show is being run in accordance with the guidance in The Showing Council's Blueprint. Some of this guidance may change in the run up to the show so please keep looking at the website / facebook page. The following rules apply

- 1** Organisers and landowners will not hold themselves responsible for any accident / injury to any person, animal or property whatsoever or however caused. **It is a condition of entry to the showground that all persons agree to indemnify the promoters and landowners against any legal action.**
 - 2 RESPECT THE OFFICIALS OR BE ASKED TO LEAVE. This applies to all persons entering the Showground**
 - 3** Competitors entering classes which may clash do so entirely at their own risk. No entry fees will be refunded unless accompanied by a doctor's or veterinary certificate. **THE ORGANISERS RESERVE THE RIGHT TO REFUSE AN ENTRY WITHOUT STATING THE REASON.**
 - 4** **Objections** must be made in writing to the Secretary within 10 minutes of an incident, together with a £20 deposit which will be refunded if the objection is upheld
 - 5** Organisers reserve the right to alter, amalgamate or sub-divide classes should numbers so justify or to substitute other judges for those named. Judges' decisions are final.
 - 6 All Health & Safety Notices / Rules must be followed at all times including safety dress code rulings.**
 - 7 NO galloping / cantering** on showground except in arenas / practice area.
 - 8 Please TAKE YOUR LITTER HOME WITH YOU. Do not muck your horseboxes out onto the ground**
 - 9** No horse/pony under 4 years of age to be ridden on showground
 - 10** Horses/Ponies must not be left tied up & unattended. Failure to return to the area when called could lead to a fine, permanent exclusion from the show ground and / or prosecution.
 - 11 DOGS** must be on lead & not left unattended in vehicles in hot weather
 - 12 A FRANCHISE** to operate on the showground must have been obtained from the organisers in order to carry out any commercial activity, including photography.
 - 13 It is essential that entries are completely filled out and signed that they are happy for the information to be used for show administration. Otherwise they will NOT be accepted.**
- A. Social Distancing must be followed at all times both in the ring and on the showground in general. Anyone not adhering to the Social Distancing will be reported to the appropriate Society
- B. A rider / handler may not show for more than one stables at this show
- C. Masks / face coverings to be worn in general areas. It is not advised to wear masks when mounted, if you do they must be soft and not attached to the hat
- D. follow all the official instructions – both signed and given by officials
- E. keep to your given timings
- F. remember to hand sanitise regularly
- G. Anyone with Covid Symptoms or having been contacted by Track and Trace or classified High Risk should stay away
- H. Maximum of 3 people with each horse – Rider / Handler, groom plus responsible adult if competitor under 18.
- I. all competitors under 18 should have a responsible adult with them
- J. Driver may form an extra person but must stay at vehicle
- K. no spectators permitted
- L. All Entries must be submitted before the closing date. No changes will be permitted on the day.
- M. Entry Forms must have full details of all attendees and the vehicle for Track and Trace purposes. If there are any changes please inform the Secretary before show day. It is the responsibility of the Competitor to ensure that full details have been submitted. Anyone not listed will not be permitted to enter the showground.
- N. Vehicle passes must be prominently displayed. No pass = No entry.
- O. Back Numbers will be sent with your vehicle pass. Please remember them.
- P. Competitors must observe gathering limits at all times in all areas. This is currently 6.
- Q. Competitors to use own toilet facilities in lorry
- R. Litter – all competitors must take ALL litter home due to risk of contamination
- S. Result / Mark sheets will be posted on line after the show. They will not be available on the showground.
- T. One way system must be followed at all times.
- U. Ridden classes may be stripped. Grooms must not remain in the ring any longer than necessary. Grooms must wear face coverings at all times. Riders should wear face coverings when dismounted and must stick to their own 2m space. The groom is responsible for riders being able to remount. The stewards may not help.
- V. Rosettes will be handed out by the Marshall wearing PPE.
- W. Upon leaving the Arena you must return immediately to your vehicle and stay there until your next class. Once finished please leave as soon as possible.
- X. socialising or watching classes in which there is no involvement is discouraged
