COVID-19

Our aim is to provide you all with a fun and enjoyable day's showing, so please help us out by following the current Covid-19 government guidelines. Stewards will be on site throughout the day and monitoring social distancing. Please follow instruction when asked to do so. We would ask if all attendees could fill in our track and trace or QR code before entering the premises.

Anyone showing any symptoms or has been in contact with anyone showing symptoms of Covid-19 must not attend the show.

Unfortunately, due to Covid-19, this show is held behind closed doors therefore, only competitors & grooms will be admitted. No spectators are allowed. No more than 3 people per horse.

Park cars and Lorries with an adequate distance in accordance with social distancing and as indicated by our parking attendant.

Lorry toilets to be used where possible to minimise the risk.

We ask for all people to keep their distance. No congregating in entrances or walkways.

Our collecting/warm up ring will be manned and therefore will be limited numbers allowed in at any one time.

Show Organisers have taken responsibility to set safeguards in place for exhibitors but attendance at the Show is at your own risk.

WE EXPECT ALL VISITORS TO TAKE PERSONAL RESPONSIBILITY FOR NOT SPREADING THE VIRUS AND FOLLOWING ALL RULES REGARDING SOCIAL DISTANCING, WEARING OF MASKS AND SANITISING WERE POSSIBLE. FAILURE TO DO SO WILL RESULT IN REMOVAL FROM THE SHOWGROUND.

SHOW RULES

1. The Judge's decision is final. Any complaints regarding the judge's decision will not be accepted.
2. All ages for both horse & rider are taken from the 1st of January in the current year. All riders/handlers must have attained their 3rd birthday on the date of the show. All ridden horse/ponies must be at least 4yrs old to compete in any ridden class.
3. The centre reserves the right to alter, amalgamate or cancel classes if sufficient/insufficient entries.
4. Hard Hats to current BSI standards with a chin strap to be worn in all ridden classes and in-hand classes by handlers 16 years and under.
5. No refund of entries will be allowed under any circumstances.
6. The organisers accept no responsibility or liability for any loss, incident or accident(s) to persons, equines or property.
7. All competitors must hold a minimum of third-party liability insurance.
8. No mucking out of horseboxes on the showground.
9. The Centre reserves the right to ask anyone demonstrating cruelty or anti-social behaviour to leave the showground and will be banned from any future events.
10. If you are not present when your class is due to start, then you will not be allowed into the ring once the class has started. It is the competitor's responsibility to ensure that they do not miss their class. There will be no refunds if any class is missed.
11. Novice classes – Please enter this class in the spirit that it is intended.
12. No spurs are allowed to be worn by any competitor under the age of 16yrs in any class. Any competitor over the age of 16yrs may wear spurs if riding a horse exceeding 148cms and if the class allows it.
13. No form of bullying, harassment or nasty comments, whether in person or on social media will not be tolerated and any person found to be doing so will be banned from all events and removed from the showground immediately.
14. Foals must be at least 30 days old on the show day.
15. No horse/pony to be left tied to a trailer/lorry unattended.
16. All stallions and colts 2 years+ must be bitted. Age of handlers for stallions or colts, or riders of stallions as follows: Stallions/Colts not exceeding 13.2hh- minimum age of handler/rider 12yrs. Stallions/Colts 13.2hh and over – minimum age of handler/rider 14yrs.
17. Lead rein handlers must be at least 16 years of age.
18. Take all rubbish & waste home.
19. When attending the show, please respect our liveries by remaining off the yards and no wandering around the premises.

SCHEDULE

In-hand

Ring 1 – 8:30am start (Judge Brian Teat)

1. Youngstock – 3 years and under inc. foals. Foals can be shown at foot.
2. Tack & Turnout.
3. Small breeds M&M including welsh.
4. In-hand pony – any age & type.
5. In-hand Shetland/miniature.
6. Young Handler.
7. In-hand part bred.

In-hand Championship ring 1.

Sash to champion & rosette to reserve. Champion to receive arena hire voucher.

All first placings in classes 1 to 7 are eligible to compete.

Ring 2 – 8:30am start (Judge Richard Bowen)

8. In-hand coloured – including spotted, unusual, cremello.
9. In-hand cob- including Traditional, Hogged, Native.
10. In-hand pure bred / foreign / rare breeds.
11. In-hand Large Breeds M&M including welsh.
12. In-hand veteran – 15 years and over.
13. In-hand New combination – any age & type. In their first full show season together.
14. In-hand Horse – any age, any type.

In-hand Championship ring 2.

Sash to champion & rosette to reserve. Champion to receive arena hire voucher.

All first placings in classes 8 to 14 are eligible to compete.

In-hand Supreme

Luxury Sashes to champion & reserve.

All In-hand champions & reserves are eligible to compete.

Ridden

Ring 1 Novice Ridden (Not before 12pm)

Judges: Richard Bowen/Brian Teat.

15. Ridden Pre-Novice walk & trot ponies – 4 years old and over. Ponies not to exceed 148cms. Snaffle bridles only. NO CANTER.
16. Ridden Pre-Novice walk & trot horses – 4 years old and over. Horses exceeding 148cms. Snaffle bridles only. NO CANTER.
17. Ridden Novice ponies – 4 years old and over. Ponies not to exceed 148cms. Walk & trot go-round, canter in individual show.
18. Ridden Novice horses – 4 years old and over. Horses exceeding 148cms. Walk & trot go-round, canter in individual show.
19. Ridden Novice 4, 5 & 6 year olds – open to any horse or pony.
20. Ridden Novice rider – open to any pony or horse 4 years old and over. Nervous/novice riders only.

Novice ridden Championship.

Sash to champion & rosette to reserve. Champion to receive arena hire voucher.

All first placings in classes 15 – 20 are eligible to compete.

Ring 1 Open Ridden

21. Ridden Tack & Turnout.
22. Lead-rein – 4 years old and over. Lead-rein riders not to have attained their 10th birthday before the 1st Jan 2021.
23. First ridden – 4 years old and over. First ridden riders not to have attained their 12th birthday before the 1st Jan 2021.
24. Ridden most promising new combination – 4 years old and over. Any type, any height. Horses & ponies. To be in their first full show season together.
25. Ridden part bred – 4 years old and over. Any height.
26. Ridden M&M small breeds – including welsh, 4 years old and over.

Open Ridden Championship 1.

Sash to champion & rosette to reserve. Champion to receive arena hire voucher.

All first placings in classes 21 - 26 are eligible to compete.

Ring 1 Open Ridden

27. Ridden M&M large breeds – Including welsh, 4 years old and over.
28. Ridden pure bred / foreign / rare breeds. – 4 years old and over.
29. Ridden cob- including Traditional, Hogged, Native. – 4 years old and over.
30. Ridden coloured – including spotted, unusual, cremello. 4 years old and over.
31. Ridden veteran – 15 years and over.
32. Ridden hunter pony/horse – 4 years old and over.

Open Ridden Championship 2.

Sash to champion & rosette to reserve. Champion to receive arena hire voucher.

All first placings in classes 27 - 32 are eligible to compete.

Ridden Supreme

Luxury Sashes to champion & reserve.

All ridden champions & reserves are eligible to compete.
