We will be running clear rounds over the show jump and cross-country courses for £10 per round.

SCHEDULE

EVENTERS' CHALLENGE:

CLASS 1: Eventers Challenge 30cm (may be assisted) Cross poles only, with no back poles

CLASS 2: Eventers Challenge 40cm (may be assisted)

CLASS 3: Eventers Challenge 50cm

CLASS 4: Eventers Challenge 60cm

CLASS 5: Eventers Challenge 70cm

CLASS 6: Eventers Challenge 80cm

CLASS 7: Eventers Challenge 85cm Plus

Class heights: the class height is the maximum height of fences in the first section; fences in the jump-off section may be increased by up to 5cm over the class height.

One Day Event

Dressage Tests can be called in all classes

CLASS 8: Mini (20-30cm)

May be on the Lead Rein/Assisted or Unassisted

Dressage Test: Pony Club Walk Trot Test 2012 - Whips allowed

No back poles in show jumping course. Shorted XC course, fences approx. 20 – 30cm.

CLASS 9: Intro (Approx. 40cm)

No assistance other than calling the test

Dressage Test: Intro B (2009) - Whips allowed.

CLASS 10: Novice (Approx. 50cm)

No assistance other than calling the test

Dressage Test: Intro B (2009) - Whips allowed.

CLASS 11: Novice Plus (Approx. 60cm)

No assistance other than calling the test

Dressage test: Prelim 12 (2005) - Whips allowed.

CLASS 12: Intermediate (Approx. 70cm)

No assistance other than calling the test

Dressage test: BE90 Dressage Test 95 – No whips allowed,

CLASS 13: Open (Approx. 80cm)

No assistance other than calling the test

Dressage test: BE90 Dressage Test 95 – No whips allowed.

CLASS 14: Open Plus (Approx. 85cm plus)

No assistance other than calling the test

Dressage test: BE90 Dressage Test 95 – No whips allowed.

The Water is included in all ODE classes, can be missed but will receive 10 penalty points.

All Eventers Challenge classes will include a clearly marked timed section

Please note that if there are insufficient entries in classes / divisions then the placings may be combined.

CLOSING DATE: The Thursday before the competition. If classes are full before the closing date, then a waiting list will be held. Start Time: Class 1, will not start before 9.00am

TIMES: Start lists with times will be on the Tumpy Green Equestrian Centre's Facebook page; by the evening of Friday before the competition.

PRIZEGIVING: Class presentations will take place immediately after each class. Rosettes: to sixth place in each class.

NUMBER BIBS: Number bib holders will be required to display the provided numbers. A small selection are available to hire at a cost of £5 hire plus £10 deposit per bib.

ONE DAY EVENT RULES

ODE classes are run according to the Pony Club 2021 Eventing Rulebook.

PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING FOR DRESSAGE – BITS & WHIPS

Classes 1, 2,3, 4 & 5 - the Dressage test may be ridden in **any normal riding bit** (such as a snaffle, gag, or pelham type with a straight bar, single joint or French link), and **whips are allowed**.

Classes 6, 7 & 8 the Dressage test must be ridden in a **snaffle type bit and no whips are allowed**.

DISCLAIMERS

1. Save for the death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of this event or The Pony Club / Riding Club nor any agent, employee, or representative of these bodies, nor the landlord or his tenant, accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land , cars/ lorries/trailers, their contents and accessories or any other personal property whatsoever, whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract or in any way whatsoever. Entries are only accepted on this basis.

2. The organisers of this event have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present at this event. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents. They must obey the instructions of the organisers and all officials and stewards.

3. All non Pony Club competitors are not covered by The Pony Club insurance and must have their own third party cover. The Tumpy Green Branch of The Pony Club and the organisers of this event are not legally responsible for non-Members and their insurance will not cover them.

RULES AND NOTICES

1. Substitutions allowed – please tell the Secretary via email before times are published; once times are published, please tell the secretary on the day.
2. Pre-entries are essential as entries will be limited. If you miss the closing date please ring/ email the Entries Secretary for available spaces.
3. Closing date for entries – Wednesday before the competition. Withdrawal refunds given on receipt of a relevant doctor/vet certificate received by the Entries Secretary within a week of the competition (please enclose an s.a.e.)
4. If the show is cancelled due to circumstances beyond our control, entry fees will be help in credit for a future event. Any refund will be subject to an administration fee.
5. TIMES WILL BE GIVEN – please see the Tumpy Green Facebook page. Competitors may be asked to jump up to 15 minutes before their given time – please be ready.
6. Warm-up Arena – the number of competitors may be restricted; please obey the steward’s instructions as to when you can use the warm-up.
7. Children must not ride in the warm-up arena without an accompanying adult. All competitors must have paid all entry and first aid fees prior to entering the warm-up. No rider will be allowed in the warm-up without their number displayed.
8. Each horse/pony may only compete once in any given class. Stallions are allowed only with prior permission from the Entries Secretary and must wear stallion discs and ribbons. All horse/ponies must be at least 4 years old on day of competition.
9. Turnout for ALL riders and horses should be as in the Pony Club / Riding Club Rules for Show-jumping 2021. Please contact the Entries Secretary BEFORE the show day for any queries re dress/turnout.
10. Any abuse of horses/ponies, officials, other competitors or members of the public will not be tolerated and those found doing so will be asked to leave the venue with no compensation and may be reported to the relevant authority.
11. Judges’ decision is final. Any objection must be handed to the Show Secretary in writing with a £20 deposit (which will be forfeited if the objection is not upheld) within 15 minutes of the incident and BEFORE the prize-giving for that class.
12. INSURANCE; please ensure that you have adequate/appropriate insurance for rider, horse, property and third party.
13. PHOTOGRAPHS: by entering this competition you are agreeing to be photographed whilst competing; these photographs may be used for future publicity. If you do not wish to be photographed please tell the photographer on entering the arena, before you jump.
14. Participants attend at their own risk; neither the Committee nor Tumpy Green Competition Centre will be liable for any loss, damage or accident to horses, riders, property or other persons.
15. No horses/ponies should be left tied to the outside of trailers/lorries without supervision. Please clear any muck/rubbish and do not leave on the lorry park. Please be aware that there is no gate between the lorry park and the main road. All hay must be collected and removed from the lorry park.
16. The show will be run under The Pony Club Show jumping and Eventing Rules 2020.

17. Please abide by social distancing guidelines by maintaining 1m apart, providing any monies in a sealed envelope, parking as instructed and restricting numbers in each warm-up area to 4 combinations.
