PLEASE READ AND ABIDE BY ALL THE RULES

Ridden Showing Starting at 9am

- Class 1: Novice Ridden Showing any height, open to combinations with no more than 3 wins.
- Class 2: Riding Horse— any height
- Class 3: Veteran Horse or Pony 15 years or over may be split depending on numbers
- Class 4: Cob open to all types of cob
- Class 5: Coloured Horse or Pony Traditional or non-traditional, may be split depending on numbers Traditional coloured horses and ponies must have feather and full mane and tail.

Non-Traditional: Plaited or hogged with no feather.

Class 6: M & M May split into large and small breeds, depending on numbers.

Small Breeds: Exmoors, Shetlands, Dartmoors, Welsh Section A & B.

Best in Show – For all combinations placed 1^{st} in classes 1-9.

Large Breeds: Connemara, Dales, Highland, Fells, New Forest, Welsh Section C & D.

Part breeds not permitted.

- Class 7: Riding Horse/Hunter May be split into horse and pony, depending on numbers.
- Class 8: Thoroughbred Open to horses bred to race, trained, have raced or retired racehorses.
- Class 9: Ridden Foreign Breeds Open to any type of part or pure-bred foreign breed of hose and ponies

- Class 10. 3 Years & Under Young Stock Open to fillies, colts and geldings aged 3yrs & under
- Class 11. Best Conditioned Horse & Pony Open to any horse and pony of any height
- Class 12. Hunter or Sports Horse over 148cm Open to hunter- and sports- type horses over 148cm
- Class 13. In-hand Cob Open to cob horses and ponies
- **Class 14. M&M** May split into large and small breeds, depending on numbers.
- Small Breeds: Exmoors, Shetlands, Dartmoors, Welsh Section A & B. Part breeds not permitted Large Breeds: Connemara, Dales, Highland, Fells, New Forest, Welsh Section C & D. Part breeds not permitted.
- **Class 15. Veteran Horse & Pony 15yrs or Over** Open to any horse and pony 15yrs or over. Veteran Horse Society and VHPRC qualifier.
- **Class 16. Coloured Horse or Pony** Traditional or non-traditional, may be split depending on numbers Traditional coloured horses and ponies must have feather and full mane and tail. Non-Traditional: Plaited or hogged with no feather.
- Class 17. Best Foreign Breed Open to any type of part or pure-bred foreign breed of hose and ponies
- Class 18: Thoroughbred Open to horses bred to race, trained, have raced or retired racehorses

Open to members and non-members. All competitors and grooms must adhere to VHS Rules in all circumstances. Failure to do so may result in immediate disqualification.

VHS Regional Final qualification. All competitors placed 1st to 4th in each age category will qualify for the corresponding class at VHS Regional Finals. Members must carry their cards in the ring and have their showing card signed by the judge in the ring as proof of qualification. Non-members will receive a red qualification card which can be exchanged for signed showing card when applying for VHS membership. It is the competitors responsibility to present their Showing card to the judge.

Regional Finals are open to members only.

All competitors are eligible to enter open classes at the National Veteran Championships, to be held at Arena UK Lincolnshire on 1st - 3rd October 2020. No qualification or membership necessary. See VHS website for schedule.

Showing classes: £10 per combination per class.

Show Jumping classes: £13 per combination per class.

Working Hunter classes: £15 per combination per class.

Late entries will be subject to a £5 per class additional fee – ENTRIES ON THE DAY ARE CASH ONLY

£3 First Aid per combination (one pony/one rider) payable in CASH ONLY

Rosettes: to sixth place in each class.

CLOSING DATE: The Thursday before the competition. Entries are available on the day if classes are not full in advance and are subject to the late entry fee. If classes are full before the closing date, then a waiting list will be held. Start Time: Class 1, will not start before 9.00am

TIMES: Start lists with times for the Show Jumping will be published on Tumpy Green Equestrian Centre's Facebook page; by the evening of Friday before the competition.

PRIZEGIVING: class presentations will take place immediately after each class.

RULES AND NOTICES

- 1. Substitutions allowed please tell the Secretary (by email before the closing date, at the show box on the day).
- 2. Closing date for entries Thursday before the competition. Withdrawal refunds given on receipt of a relevant doctor/vet certificate received by the Entries Secretary within a week of the competition (please enclose an s.a.e.)
- 3. If the show is cancelled due to circumstances beyond our control, entry fees will be help in credit for a future event. Any refund will be subject to an administration fee.
- 4. TIMES WILL BE GIVEN for SHOW-JUMPING please see the documents section of Equo Events. Competitors may be asked to jump up to 15 minutes before their given time please be ready.
- 6. Warm-up Arena the number of competitors may be restricted; please obey the steward's instructions as to when you can use the warm-up. No one will be allowed in the warm-up arenas before they have paid for entries and first aid IN FULL. Please note we only accept CASH.
- 7. Children must not jump in the warm-up arena without an accompanying adult.
- 8. Each horse/pony may only compete once in each and in a maximum of three classes. Stallions are allowed only with prior permission from the Entries Secretary via the Rider's DC and must wear stallion discs and ribbons. All horse/ponies must be at least 5 years old on day of competition.

- 9. Turnout for ALL riders and horses should be as in the Pony Club / Riding Club Rules for Show-jumping 2021. Please contact the Entries Secretary BEFORE the show day for any queries re dress/turnout.
- 10. Any abuse of horses/ponies, officials, other competitors or members of the public will not be tolerated and those found doing so will be asked to leave the venue with no compensation and may be reported to the relevant authority.
- 11. Judges' decision is final. Any objection must be handed to the Show Secretary in writing with a £20 deposit (which will be forfeited if the objection is not upheld) within 15 minutes of the incident and BEFORE the prize-giving for that class.
- 12. INSURANCE; please ensure that you have adequate/appropriate insurance for rider, horse, property and third party.
- 13. PHOTOGRAPHS: by entering this competition you are agreeing to be photographed whilst competing; these photographs may be used for future publicity. If you do not wish to be photographed please tell the photographer on entering the arena, before you jump.
- 14. Participants attend at their own risk; neither the Committee nor Tumpy Green Competition Centre will be liable for any loss, damage or accident to horses, riders, property or other persons.
- 15. No horses/ponies should be left tied to the outside of trailers/lorries without supervision. Please clear any muck/rubbish and do not leave on the lorry park. Please be aware that there is no gate between the lorry park and the main road. All hay must be collected and removed from the lorry park.
- 16. The show will be run under The Pony Club Show jumping Rules 2021 and per Trailblazers/ Veteran Horse Society rules for the showing and working hunter classes.
- 17. Please obey all instructions given by staff and adhere to current social distancing guidance.
