- No cantering between rings. Please be sensible in the warm up areas and do not crowd ring entrances.
- Please respect the landowners by not skipping out lorries onto the parking area (please take all droppings home) and use the litter bins provided
- Competitors must wear riding hats and appropriate clothing, including jackets.Body protectors are advised for jumping. Hats MUST be worn when mounted.
 - Horse abuse with whips and spurs will not be tolerated. No schooling whips allowed. Children under 16yrs may NOT wear spurs.
- 5. If the horse/pony is inclined to kick, a red ribbon MUST be displayed in its tail.
- The judge's decision is final. Any complaints must be made to the organisers within half an hour of the class ending with a £20 returnable deposit if the claim is upheld.
 - Stallions/Colts may not be LEAD OR RIDDEN by any juniors who have not attained their 16th birthday before January 1st in the current year
- 8. The event organisers have taken all reasonable safety precautions and will not be held responsible for any accident or loss to any person on the showground however caused. Riders are advised to have their own third party Public Liability.
 - Dogs MUST be on a lead and PLEASE pick up your dogs waste!

COVID Measures

- By entering the Jasmyn Chan Memorial Show 2021, you are agreeing to adhere to all the rules set out.
- Entries on the day only. To reduce queuing and gathering at the entries table, there will be a CLASS ENTRY FORM for you to download and complete before arriving. These will also be available on the day, but please, where possible, complete before arriving.
- The class entry form will also ask you to list people who are coming with you for track and trace reasons. Personal information will be kept safe and secure, and destroyed once used for the purpose outlined (please see 7. for maximum people)
- 4. In-hand and ridden classes will be capped to a MAXIMUM of 10 entries per class
- Show jumping the TIMED JUMP OFF will take place DIRECTLY after you have jumped a
 clear round. This is to reduce traffic in and out of the ring. You will be given a few moments
 after your clear round to collect yourself and ask for the jump off course/numbers, if
 required, and timer will start when you're ready.
- 6. You cannot bring any horses/ponies that are not competing.
- 7. You must follow the one-way systems highlighted on the day
- Maximum of 1 ADDITIONAL PERSON per competitor (for example, a groom). Exceptions are for lead rein competitors and/or drivers, which then this increases to 2 additional people.
- Masks MUST be worn, and social distancing adhered to, at all times both in the parking field and competition field. Exceptions for mask wearing are for warming up or competing.
- Sanitiser will be available around the competition field, but we are encouraging you bring and use your own.
- Please use you own lorries or trailers for toilet facilities, where possible.
- Most importantly if you have any symptoms, feel unwell or have been told to self-isolate due to tack and trace, please DO NOT ATTEND
