Rules

- Please remember we are still competing under strict Covid 19 regulations **Under BD rules you are now permitted to bring a group of six (including rider, groom, owner, family, etc.) to shows. They must stay in their 'bubble' and not mix with others. If the spectators gallery is open (tbc) face coverings must be worn when inside and group of 6 adhered to.**
 - Social distancing must be adhered too at all times.
 - Competition will be run according to BD rules.
 - Please check tack and dress eligibility.
 - No combination may enter Intro, Prelim & Novice classes on the same day.
 - Combinations entering a Novice class may not enter an Intro Class.
 - Hard hats to current standard must be worn and fastened at all times when mounted.
 - The organizers & landowners accept no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury that may be sustained in connection with the show to any person, animal or property.
 - Competitors are requested NOT to muck out horseboxes or leave litter in the parking area. Please tidy up after yourself and pick up any horse droppings.
 - Horses & ponies must not be left unattended when tied outside to lorry/trailer.
 - Dogs to be kept on leads at all times.
 - Limited numbers will be allowed in the warm up arena for social distancing rules.
 - No sheets will be available to collect on the day, in a social distancing manner at the end of each class.
 - No helpers on foot in the warm up.
 - Please bring your own water for drinking buckets and wash down.

All persons attending will be deemed to have accepted these conditions.

An arena walk will be available for 15 minutes prior to the start of the first class.

Dressage Warm-up Etiquette

Please remember to pass left hand to left when riding in the warm up area, and when in walk, stay off the outer track.
