All Covid-19 precautions will be observed during the event.

Start between 09.00 and 12.00

There will be two routes of approximately 6 miles and 12 miles.

The ride will take place over a mixture of private land and public rights of way, enjoying panoramic views.

Entries: Adults £20 - Under 16 years old £15

Due to Covid-19 unfortunately we are unable to accept any entries on the day: **all registration and payment must be made online.**

Cancellation: should it be necessary to cancel the event at short notice you will be notified by email. Please see conditions below.

First aid: there will be no paramedic at the event, but first aiders will be present. Riders participate at their own risk.

A delicious selection of **food and refreshments** will be available in the lorry park; drinks, tea and coffee, homemade cakes and a BBQ. There will be a refreshment stop out on the ride as well.

Directions: Rye Hill Farm is on the minor road between Longbridge Deverill and Maiden Bradley. The postcode will take you to the farm drive's entrance, where you will see "SWW RIDE" signs.

From the A350: come in to the centre of Longbridge Deverill and the minor road to Rye Hill is immediately next to The George Inn. It is signed to Maiden Bradley. When approaching from Warminster the turning is before the pub on the right, if you are coming from Shaftesbury the turning is immediately after the pub on the left. The left turning to Rye Hill Farm is 1.1 miles on the left.

From the West (from Maiden Bradley): take the minor road, sign posted to Longbridge Deverill and Horningsham, continue on the road for approximately 3.2 miles, keeping right after 2 miles where the road forks and look out for the "SWW RIDE" signs signalling the right-hand turn to Rye Hill Farm. Take care on the sharp right turning to the farm.

RULES AND CONDITIONS:

1. Hard hats conforming to current safety standards must be worn by **all** riders when mounted.
2. The minimum age for horses and ponies is 4 years.
- 3 Riders must not deviate from the marked course and every effort should be made to respect slower or faster riders to avoid upsetting horses. Please overtake with care and warning.
4. Although your dogs are welcome, they **must** be on a lead at **all** times whilst in the lorry park and no dogs are to be taken on the ride by horse riders.
5. All riders must report to the Secretary on arrival and no rider may start until money has been received.
6. Instructions from course stewards **must** be obeyed.
7. Riders are required to have public liability insurance.
8. The S&WW Hunt, organisers & landowners involved in this ride accept no liability for any loss, injury or damage to any equine, person or their property and equipment, however caused.
9. All cars, lorries and horseboxes are parked at the owner's risk. No responsibility is accepted for damage or loss from the above parked on the ground.
10. In the Event of Cancellation or Postponement, riders must contact the Secretary to claim any refund within 14 days of the original event date (1st August 2021).
11. No refunds (less £2 admin fee) will be given without receipt of Doctors or Vet Certificate.
12. All those entering this event will be deemed to have accepted the above conditions.
