This will be a 'HAVE A GO' non competitive Hunter Trial. There will be no judging of fences or timing. Rosettes to all entrants.

There will be Paramedics, Toilets and a Catering unit on site. There will be a vet on call. Photography will be covered by Richard Weller-Poley – www.rwpphoto.com

All entries must be made and paid for in advance with a closing date of Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> September and no entries will be accepted after this date. Classes will be strictly limited. Entry fees include Paramedic cover.

In each class you can go round as an individual and/or as a pair. Every entry will have a time allocation. If you are going round more than once you would be given spaced times to allow you a rest in between. Riders would be expected to ride at their allocated times or risk being unable to take part.

You can walk the course the day before and a course map and fence photos will be emailed to entrants prior to the event.

No numbers will be given out. Riders will be registered by a steward at the collecting ring before their start time. Riders must be at the collecting ring 6 minutes before their start time.

There will be an open warm up area next to the collecting ring. All riders and anyone in their group would be expected to ensure their own hygiene arrangements.

Parking—the parking field is extremely large and entrants are asked to park with 10 metre distances between boxes.
