### Important Information:

Warm up will be on a surface in the “Vinny” Arena.

Dressage tests will be the indoor arena and jumping in the GG arena outside.

You will be allocated a dressage time, you will then have 30 minutes to complete your jumping round including your warm up. Warm up jumping will be over 2 specific jumps of the course.

The jumping course will be timed from start to finish

*Highest dressage test with lowest jumping faults wins – in the event of a tie between competitors – the collectives will be used, followed by the speed of the jumping course.*

## **COVID ON THE DAY RULES**

1. Please adhere to social distancing rules at all times.
2. Please park where you are told to and give each horsebox distance between you
3. No more than 5 riders in the warm up arena at any one time.
4. Secretarys Box will be in the GG Arena area

## **COMPETITION RULES**

1. The committee reserve the right to cancel, amend or alter the order of events.
2. The committee reserve the right to refuse entry or disqualify any animal that is deemed unfit to compete.
3. The committee and landowners will not be responsible for any injuries arising from accidents to persons or animals, or theft of properties on the grounds during the event.
4. The Judges and the Committee's decision shall be final on all matters during the event.
5. Any objections are to be handed to the Secretary in writing within 30 minutes of the incident, with a deposit of £20 to be forfeited if the objection is not upheld.
6. This showground is kindly lent to us; the show is run entirely by volunteers. Anyone using unreasonable behaviour, bad language, dropping litter, mucking out on the showground, mistreating any animal or anything else that affect the Club's reputation, will be asked to leave the showground.
7. Hard hats are compulsory at all times when mounted and must conform to the current BRC safety standards. Body Protectors are recommended for jumping classes.
8. All horses and ponies must be at least 4 years old to compete.
9. All dogs must be kept on leads at all times; failure to do so will result in you being asked to leave the showground. Please clear up after your dog.
10. All classes will be run under current British Riding Club rules.
11. Strictly no cantering / galloping on the showground, except in the practice rings provided.
12. Stallions are eligible to compete at this show, but all BRC rules apply and stallion discs must be worn on both sides of the bridle.
13. All horses on the showground must have been vaccinated against Equine Influenza. Passports **will** be checked for all horses competing in the Area qualifier and spot checks may be done for all other horses. Please make your passport available when picking up your number from the secretary.
14. All riders must be covered by third party insurance to compete at this event.

### **Body Protectors**

The organisers encourage riders to wear a body protector for the showjumping phase, but this is not mandatory

### **Vaccinations**

**ALL COMPETING HORSES MUST BE VACCINATED ANNUALLY**

### **Microchips**

From 1st OCTOBER 2020, IT IS A LEGAL REQUIREMENT TO HAVE YOUR HORSE MICROCHIPPED.
