Rules and Conditions of Entry

1. All persons entering the show ground shall be bound by these rules and regulations.
2. The Organising Committee do not accept liability for damage, any accident or injury of any kind to any person, animal or property whatsoever.
3. The Judges decision is final.
4. The Committee reserves the right to refuse an entry/entries without reason, alter the time, date and schedule and allocation of prizes.
5. Any competitor who, in the eyes of the judges ill treats or causes unnecessary suffering to any horse or pony will be asked to leave the showground.
6. Competition will be run under British Riding Club rules. Where a situation isn't covered in the BRC rulebook, British Dressage or British Show Jumping rules will take effect.
7. Under BRC rules faults will be incurred as follows for the SJ classes:

Knocking down any part of an obstacle including the wing	4 faults
First disobedience on the whole course	4 faults
Second disobedience on the whole course	8 faults
Third disobedience on the whole course	Elimination
First fall of rider on the whole course	Elimination
Fall of horse	Elimination
Every second commenced over time allowed	1 time penalty
8. Under BRC rules the combined training classes will be scored as follows:

Dressage test percentage subtracted from 100 to give penalty score, rounded to 1 decimal point
Show jumping faults awarded as above with the faults being added to the penalty score from dressage
In the event of equality, the lowest dressage penalty score wins
If still equality, the fastest time taken in the timed section of the show jumping course shall be the deciding factor.
9. Horses/ponies may only compete a maximum of four SJ rounds **or** 3 dressage tests **or** 2 combined training classes (or a combination thereof, within reason).
10. Warm up fences may only be at or below the height of the class being jumped. This will be monitored.
11. Protective hats must be worn up to current BRC standard (see rule book for full details). Spot checks will be carried out. No refunds will be given if a competitor is not allowed to compete due to their hat not being of an acceptable standard.
12. Body protectors with a BETA Level 3 purple label 2009 or later are strongly recommended in the jumping classes
13. The use of headcams is prohibited under BRC rules. This includes use on the head, chest, bridle or any other part of the horse or rider.
14. It is regretted that no entry fees can be refunded.
15. Objections must be made in writing and given to the Secretary within 15 minutes of the incident, with a deposit of £20.00, which will be returned if the objection is upheld.
16. Horses must not be left unattended when tied to the outside of lorries or trailers and all droppings, hay and litter **MUST** be removed from the car park.
17. Dogs must be on a short lead at all times and kept under control. They must not be tied to the outside of vehicles.
18. BRC members are covered for individual public liability insurance while at the event. Non-BRC members need to have their own public liability insurance.
19. SRC or some of our sponsors may use the winners' photos on website, Facebook page or in promotional material. If you **DO NOT** want your photo used, you must inform the secretary. This is a condition of entry.

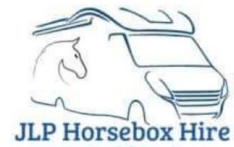
