

OPEN DRESSAGE COMPETITION On Thursday 28th October 2021

At Crokers Farm, Ipplepen TQ9 6NQ Start times 9.00am onwards. All tests are on a surface.

All riders must be 16 years or under on the day of the competition.

<u>Class 1 – Walk Trot test 2013</u> – section a) lead rein OR assisted, can be beside rider but NOT hold pony – if entries sufficient class will be split b) unassisted. Please state section on entry form.

<u>Class 2 – Pony Club D Level walk trot Dressage Test 2012</u> – section a) lead rein OR assisted, can be beside rider but NOT hold pony – if entries sufficient class will be split b) unassisted. Please state section on entry form.

<u>Class 3 – Pony Club Introduction to Dressage Test 2019</u> – section a) 9 years and under b) 10 years and over. Please state section on entry form.

<u>Class 4 – E Riders Intro Pairs Relay</u> – open to any 2 riders, lead rein allowed. Very simple test. GIVE IT A GO!

<u>Class 5 – E Riders Prancing with Poles Level 1a</u> – section a) 9 years and under b) 10 years and over. Please state section on entry form.

<u>Class 6 – E Riders Intro Level Dressage & Jumping (two jumps max height 40cm)</u> – section a) 9 years and under b) 10 years and over. Please state section on entry form

All Pony Club tests (class 1-3) can be downloaded from the Pony Club website.

All E Rider tests (class 4-6) can be downloaded from https://www.e-riders.co.uk Callers allowed in all classes. Competition is run under Pony Club Dressage rules 2020.

Entry fee – £8.00

<u>Prizes</u> – prize to highest placed SDW rider in each Test. Rosettes awarded to 6th place. Class 1- rosettes to all. <u>Entries close</u> – Saturday 23rd October.

Rules



Entries are accepted and admission granted only subject to the following conditions and it is a condition of entry that these have been accepted by each competitor. All classes will be run in accordance with Pony Club Dressage Rules 2020. You can view the rules at www.pcuk.org.

The organisers have taken every precaution to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organiser and all officials and stewards.

Save for the death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers, or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of this event or The Pony Club nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies, nor the Landlord or his tenant, accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars, their contents or accessories, or any other personal property whatsoever, whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract or in any other way whatsoever. Entries are only accepted on this basis.

The Judge's decision is final and any objections must be accompanied by £25 deposit which will be returned if upheld. Horse/Pony must be 4 years or over on day of show. All dogs must be kept on lead.

The Organisers reserve the right to refuse entry without stating a reason and to eliminate any competitor who in their opinion places themselves or others in danger or fails to observe the rules.

Covid 19 Rules

- Social distancing is to be practised at all times. The latest COVID guidance from Pony Club is available here https://pcuk.org/coronavirus-advice/
- Strictly only one additional supporter to come with each combination if you are unable to adhere to this rule for logistical reasons please do not enter.
- Lead rein combinations will be counted as two people in the warm up area.
- Please bring your own hand sanitiser and face mask for emergency use.
- Maximum numbers in the warm up area should not exceed four riders at any one time with one additional team helper. Each competitor is responsible for ensuring their tack is safe.
- No spectators or parents in the warm up area. The warm up arena will be stewarded and only a maximum of five competitors may be in the warm up at the same time. The steward may limit numbers further at their discretion.
- Riders should maintain a suitable horse distance apart from other competitors.
