Government guidelines will be followed including risk assessments.

Anyone showing any symptoms or who have been in contact with anyone showing symptoms of Covid-19 must not attend the show.

We highly recommend you bring your own hand sanitizing gel with you and that you use it on a regular basis.

Face masks are not mandatory and are a personal choice but you will need to supply your own should you wish to wear one.

Keep your distance, please do not congregate in walkways or entrances. If everyone keeps their distance and uses their common sense and is sensible whilst following the guidelines in place, we can all help make this an enjoyable days showing for everyone.

**DETAILS ON HOW TO ENTER CAN BE FOUND IN THE SCHEDULE**

## RULES

1. The Judge's decision is final. Any complaints regarding the judges decision will not be accepted.
2. Any objection must be lodged in writing within 10 minutes of class closing together with a £20 fee which will be returned if the objection is upheld. Where an objection is lodged towards the height of a horse or pony, if a valid height certificate cannot be produced on the day then the objection will stand and the animal will be disqualified from the class and the prize (if awarded one) will be taken off them and handed to the next eligible competitor. Where the objection relates to an age of a competitor, a valid form of ID will be required to prove their age. If this cannot be produced on the day then the objection will stand and the rider will be disqualified from the class and the prize (if awarded one) will be taken off them and handed to the next eligible competitor.
3. All ages for both horse & rider are taken from the 1st of January in the current year. All riders/handlers must have attained their 3rd birthday on the date of the show. All ridden horse/ponies must be atleast 4yrs old to compete in a ridden class.
4. The Organisation reserve the right to alter, amalgamate or cancel classes if sufficient/insufficient entries.
5. Hard Hats to current BSI standards with a chin strap to be worn in all ridden classes, and in-hand classes by handlers 16 years and under unless a Non-Standard Hat Disclaimer is signed. Non-Standard Hat Disclaimer cards must be carried by competitors at all times and produced to the ring steward upon entering the ring. Top Hats may be worn in Championships & Supreme Championship.
6. Whips are not to exceed 30".
7. No refund of entries will be allowed under any circumstances. If we have to cancel the show, all entries will be refunded minus a £5 per competitor administration fee.
8. The organisers accept no responsibility or liability for any loss, incident or accident(s) to persons, equines or property. The Landowners of this show will not be held responsible in any way for any loss, damage or injury in any way. All competitors should hold a minimum of third party liability insurance.
9. No Mucking out of horseboxes on the showground.
10. The Organisers reserve the right to ask any one demonstrating cruelty or anti-social behaviour to leave the showground and will be banned from any future events.
11. IF YOU ARE NOT PRESENT WHEN YOUR CLASS IS DUE TO START THEN YOU WILL NOT BE ALLOWED INTO THE RING ONCE THE CLASS HAS STARTED. IT IS UP TO THE COMPETITOR TO ENSURE THEY DO NOT MISS THEIR CLASS. YOU WILL NOT BE REFUNDED IF YOU MISS A CLASS.
12. WALK & TROT and NOVICE CLASSES – Any horse or pony that has been placed 1st in any Open Ridden class before the 1st Jan 2020 is not eligible for these classes. Please enter this class in the spirit that it is intended.
13. No spurs are allowed to be worn by any competitor under the age of 16yrs in any class. Any competitor over the age of 16yrs may wear spurs if riding a horse exceeding 148cms and if the class allows it.
14. **No form of bullying, harassment or nasty comments, whether in person or on social media will not be tolerated and any person found to be doing so will be banned from all events and removed from the showground immediately. Any online bullying will be reported to police and appropriate action will be taken.**
15. Foals must be atleast 30 days old on the show day. No mare with a foal at foot may compete in ridden classes.
16. No horse/pony to be left tied to a trailer/lorry unattended.
17. All animals attending the show must be competently handled/ridden, any unruly animals, mare, gelding, filly, stallion or colt, will be asked to leave the showground as a matter of safety. All stallions and colts 2 years+ must be bitted. Age of handlers for stallions or colts, or riders of stallions as follows: Stallions/Colts not exc 13.2hh- minimum age of handler/rider 14yrs. Stallions/Colts 13.2hh and over – minimum age of handler/rider 16yrs. Lead rein handlers must be atleast 17yrs of age and fully competent.
18. **By entering the show you are accepting these rules.**

## **Indoor Arena - In hand 9am start**

1. **Youngstock** – 3yrs old & under inc foals. Foals can be shown at foot
2. **In-hand M&M and Welsh**
3. **In-hand Pony** – Any age & type
4. **In-hand Part Bred** – Open to any part bred
5. **In-hand Pure Bred / Foreign / Rare Breeds** – including heavy horses.
6. **Best Condition** – Any age & type
7. **In-hand Veteran** – 15yrs and over
8. **In-hand Hogged / Native / Traditional / Gypsy Cob**
9. **In-hand Horse** – Any age & type
10. **In-hand Shetland / Miniature / Miniature Horse** – Any age
11. **In-hand Coloured** – including unusual coloured
12. **In-Hand Most Promising New Combination** – Any age & type. To be in their 1<sup>st</sup> full show season together.

### **Supreme In-hand Championship – all 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> prize winners from classes 1 - 12**

## **Ridden Classes – Not before 12.30pm**

These classes will not start before 12.30pm but may start later depending how busy the morning classes are.

13. **Ridden Walk & Trot** – 4yrs old & over (will split into horses & ponies if sufficient entries) Animals not to have won a 1<sup>st</sup> before 01.01.21 in any open ridden class. Snaffle Bridles Only.
14. **Ridden Novice Ponies** – 4yrs old & over (will split into horses & ponies if sufficient entries) Animals not to have won a 1<sup>st</sup> before 01.01.21 in any open ridden class. Any Suitable Bridle. Walk & trot on the go-round, canter required in individual show. (No Lead Reins)
15. **Novice Rider** – Open to any novice or nervous rider aged 3yrs old and over. Lead reins welcome. Animals to be 4yrs old & over. Walk & trot only. Lead Reins welcome.

### **Novice Championship for all 1st & 2nd prize winners from classes 13 - 15**

16. **Lead Rein Pony** – 4yrs old & over. Riders not to have attained their 10<sup>th</sup> birthday before the 01.01.21. Ponies not exceeding 128cms.
17. **First Ridden Pony** – 4yrs old & over. Riders not to have attained their 12<sup>th</sup> birthday before the 01.01.21. Ponies not exceeding 128cms.

### **Mini Championship for all 1st & 2nd prize winners from classes 16 - 18**

18. **Ridden 4, 5 & 6yr old** – Open to any horse/pony aged 4, 5 & 6yrs old.
19. **Ridden Veteran – 15yrs & over**
20. **Ridden Most Promising New Combination** – 4yrs old & over. Any type. To be in their 1<sup>st</sup> full show season together.
21. **Ridden Hunter Horse/Pony** – 4yrs old & over
22. **Ridden Part Bred** – 4yrs old & over
23. **Ridden Pure Bred / Foreign / Rare Breeds** – 4yrs old & over.
24. **Ridden Hogged Cob / Native / Traditional / Gypsy Cob** – 4yrs old & over
25. **Ridden Open Showing** – 4yrs old & over, any type
26. **Ridden M&M & Welsh** – 4yrs old & over
27. **Ridden Coloured** – 4yrs old & over

# Entering Instructions

Please follow these instructions when doing your entries, failure to do so will result in your entry not being accepted and returned.

***This will be decided the Friday before each show***
