Horse and Pony AS Entries Warrant)

8.40am Class 3 – Novice Rider – Any Age - Snaffle Bridles, No Spurs, Walk Trot Only – To be A Genuine Novice rider

9.00am Class 4 – Beginners Showing - Any Age - Snaffle Bridles, No Spurs, Walk Trot Only to be in first 3 Years of showing,
aimed at the New to Showing, have a Go Competitor.

Award to Best Yearling, 2 yo & 3 yo

12.40 Class 13 – In Hand Other Type – Arabs, Freisian, Spotted, Miniature Horses Etc Not Catered For within other classes
