



## SCHEDULE OF CLASSES

Classes open to Children up to the age of 14, lead rein, assisted and unassisted. Ponies only 14.2 and under. Vaccinations within 12 months of date of competition, please remember to bring pony passport.

This competition is for genuine novice combinations and to encourage new combinations.

**Every class will include a Festive Dress competition** (*must be safe to jump in! No bells!*), can be rider, pony, or both. We are really looking forward to seeing your Festive costumes, jumpers, hats anything Christmassy.

**Best Festive Dress Rosette for each class** (excluding Fancy Dress, Accumulator and Handy Pony Classes)

### Start 8.30 am - JUMPING CLASSES

Entry Fee: £12 per class (Ledbury Members £11) inc First Aid Contribution. (Horse-Events non-refundable booking fee of £1.45)

Special Fancy Dress Class: £10. (Horse-Events non-refundable booking fee £1.00)

*Please be aware that there will be a small warm up arena and numbers will be limited to 4 in the warm-up. As each rider moves from the warm-up to the holding area, then another rider will be allowed to enter the warm-up. In all classes Lead Rein can enter assisted but cannot enter unassisted as well. Assisted can enter unassisted.*

CLASS 1A Poles on the ground - Lead Rein

CLASS 1B Poles on the ground - Assisted

CLASS 2A 30 cm cross poles - Lead Rein

CLASS 2B 30 cm cross poles - Assisted

CLASS 3A Christmas Ride and Run 30cm cross poles – 6 jumps – Lead Rein

CLASS 3B Christmas Ride and Run 30cm cross poles – 6 jumps - Assisted

CLASS 3C Christmas Ride and Run 30cm cross poles – 6 jumps – Unassisted

Each competitor will ride the course and then enter a holding box where someone can hold their pony, so they can run the course. It will be timed from the beginning to the end and fastest wins.

### Approx. 11.30am - SPECIAL CLASS (non-jumping) – FANCY DRESS competition.

This class is for all the family, for the most festive, Christmassy, fun, creative costumes for rider and ponies.

It will be split into TWO sections

A - Best Fancy Dress Individual, rider, and pony

B - Best Fancy Dress more than 1 person / or group

## SCHEDULE OF CLASSES - CHANGE OF COURSE

**CLASS 4A**      **40 cm show jumps**– Lead Rein  
**CLASS 4B**      **40 cm show jumps** – Assisted\* (\*The assistant may touch the rider and/or pony with no penalty.)

**CLASS 4C**      **40 cm show jumps** – Unassisted only  
The course will be single phase, with the whole course set at 40cm; the second section will be timed and used to decide placings. Faults accumulative over the whole course.

**CLASS 5A**      **50 cm show jumps** – Assisted\* (\*The assistant may touch the rider and/or pony with no penalty.)

**CLASS 5B**      **50 cm show jumps** – Unassisted only  
The course will be single phase, with the whole course set at 50cm; the second section will be timed and used to decide placings. Faults accumulative over the whole course.

**CLASS 6**      **CHRISTMAS SPECIAL CLASS - 50 cm ACCUMULATOR. 8 fences.**

Each cleared fence is worth the points is numbered as eg: Fence 1 = 1 point, Fence 2 = 2 points, Fence 3 = 3 points and so on. Choose to jump Fence 8 **OR Jump the JOKER instead which will be 60cm. Joker fence is worth 20 points. If you knock the Joker down you lose 10 points**

**Refusal – after 3 refusals you will be eliminated**

**Highest points wins. If joint points total, then fastest time will be taken into account.**

**CLASS 7**      **60 cm show jumps** – Unassisted only  
The course will be single phase, with the whole course set at 60cm; the second section will be timed and used to decide placings. Faults accumulative over the whole course.

**CLASS 8A (am)**   **Morning** Handy Pony Competition – to run in outdoor arena in the morning – from 9.00am – 11.00am. Entry on the day £5. Enter with Secretary in café. Clear on all the obstacles and fastest time wins. Every entry gets Handy Pony rosette.

**CLASS 8B (pm)**   **Afternoon** Handy Pony Competition – to run in outdoor arena in the afternoon from 1.00pm – 3pm. Entry on the day £5. Enter with Secretary in café. Clear on all the obstacles and fastest time wins. Every entry gets Handy Pony rosette.

### **Rosettes:**

Classes receive a Rosette 1<sup>st</sup> – 10<sup>th</sup> place (except Fancy Dress Classes and Class 7, rosettes 1<sup>st</sup> to 6<sup>th</sup>).

All entries will receive a Christmas Rosette for taking part

All Handy Pony Entries will receive a Handy Pony Rosette

For classes 4A, 4B, 4C, 5A and 5B 1<sup>st</sup> – 10<sup>th</sup> Place and each winner will get a winning sash

There will be sweets and chocolate for riders and carrots for ponies

### **Special Fancy Dress Class**

**Section A** – Individuals – 1<sup>st</sup> to 6<sup>th</sup> Place Rosette with all other entries receiving Christmas Rosette for taking part

**Section B** – More than 1 individual / group - 1st to 6<sup>th</sup> Place Rosette, with all other entries receiving Christmas Rosette for taking part

## Rules and Conditions of Entry

### Your entry is deemed to include acceptance of these rules

1. The competition will be run in accordance with the Pony Club Show Jumping Rules 2020.
2. NO refunds will be given after the closing date.
3. **No pony may do more than 4 classes including Handy Pony.**
4. **No Spurs. Use of spurs will mean the class is ridden HC (Hors Concours, without prize and not placed)**
5. The Judge's decision is final.
6. Protests and Objections - please see Pony Club Show Jumping Rule book 2020.
7. Ponies competing may only be ridden by their competitor, at the venue.
8. No horse/pony under the age of 5 may compete in the Show Jumping.
9. The organisers reserve the right to refuse an entry, limit entry numbers, or cancel a class.
10. Abuse of the horse, bad language or behaviour will not be tolerated and will risk elimination.
11. Riding is a risk sport, spectators and competitors attend entirely at their own risk. The organisers and Moores Farm do not accept liability for any accident, damage or injury to horse, rider, spectators, or property.

**NUMBERS SHOULD BE PRINTED BY COMPETITORS and may be used in a number bib or attached to the saddlecloth; numbers should be printed as large as possible.**

### Entries

1. Telephone entries will not be accepted.
2. A booking fee will be added to each entry.
3. In the event of cancellation, £3.00 of the entry fee will be retained to defray costs. Refunds will be paid online via Horse Events
4. Once booking has closed on Wednesday 1<sup>st</sup> December, no changes to entries will be allowed.
5. **Withdrawal - PLEASE READ CAREFULLY**  
Withdrawals must be made before the closing date of the competition which is midnight on Wednesday 1st December to qualify for a refund. ALL Withdrawals must be registered by email to: info@horse-events.co.uk. Refunds exclude the booking fee.  
Please note if withdrawing after the closing date in order to obtain your refund we MUST receive a vet's or doctor's certificate no later than the 13th December following the event to obtain a refund minus a £3.00 admin fee.
6. **Event Cancellation:** As you can appreciate at this time, we cannot insure against cancelling due to Covid-19. In the event of cancellation for any reason all entries will be refunded minus a £3.00 cancellation charge per entry.

### Rider and Public Safety

1. Children are not allowed to play in the car park
2. All hats must have the current (aquamarine) Pony Club tag.
3. When not competing all horses/ponies must be kept on the horse box park or collecting rings. They must not be exercised in the car/lorry park, or among spectators. **No lunging allowed at the venue.**
4. Horses/ponies tied to trailers or lorries must not be left unattended.
5. No horses to be tied up outside trailers except for tacking up
6. No hay to be fed outside trailer
7. Please pick up all horse droppings and any rubbish before you leave
8. **NO DOGS ALLOWED**

### Event Liability

1. Save for the death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers, or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of this event or The Pony Club nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies, nor the landlord or his tenant, accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars, their contents and accessories, or any other personal property whatsoever, whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract or in any other way whatsoever. Entries are only accepted on this basis.
2. The organisers of this event have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present at this event. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents. They must obey the instructions of the organisers and all officials and stewards.
