If you qualify in the late qualifying classes during the morning, please enter your championship classes with the secretary withing 30 minutes of qualifying.

You do not have to enter the championship class in which you qualified,

You can enter any or as many championship classes as you wish.

If you qualified with a 3-year-old last year

you are still eligible to enter the youngstock classes.

Depending on entry numbers, the Judge has the right to divide /amalgamate any classes.

1st & 2nds from classes 20 - 40 will stand as Champion & Reserves. They will then stand forward into the section semi-final, 6 exhibits will then be selected from each section to stand forward for the **The Bitton & District Supreme Champion of the year.** (Evening dress optional in Supreme)

All competitors must enter at least 1 class on line via our website www.bittonhorseshow.com as this acts as our track & trace system, once entered you may then enter more classes on the day should you wish.

- 1. The Show reserves the right to amalgamate or sub divide any classes at the discretion of the Judge
- 2. The Judges decision is final
- Any objections must be handed to the secretary in writing within 15 minutes of the class, accompanied by £20.00. Deposit returnable if the objection is upheld
- 4. The Committee will not be responsible for any accident or incident to animals, persons or property.
- 5. The decisions of the Judges and Committee are final.
- 6. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by full fees.
- 7. All horses and ponies should have 3rd party and public liability insurance
- 8. All 16 years and under must wear HARD HATS when showing In hand.
- 9. No animal under the age of 4 to be ridden anywhere on the showground
- 10. No dogs allowed on the showground/arenas.
- 11, Animals must not be left unattended whilst ties to boxes
- 12. Hard Hats/healed boots must be worn at all times
- whilst mounted 13. 13 Mucking out of
- horseboxes/trailers in the lorry park is strictly forbidden.
- 14. Abusive / offensive behaviour towards Judges, show officials, competitors, Spectators will not be tolerated, Any such person will be Disqualified all entry fees will be forfeited and escorted from the show
- 15.No person shall ill-treat animals at any time.
- $16. \mbox{ ALL }$ STALLIONS must display a stallion ID Badge and be
- bitted at all times in the interest of safety, stallions may
- only be ridden / handled by persons over the age of 16 years
- 18. Arms & legs must be covered at all times whilst mounted
- 19. Trotting/ cantering is only permitted in the designated warm up area.
- 20. ENTRY FEES will NOT be refunded without a Doctor / Veterinary Certificate.
