


Hallamshire Riding Society of Sheffield

Riders 10 yrs & under - An attendant may enter the ring

Class 4 11.30am Best Ridden Pony

Class will be split Lead Rein, Small Breeds & Large Breeds

Class 6 Junior Style & Appearance, 16 yrs & under

Entries may not compete beyond Class 24 45cm

Class 22 Mountain & Moorland Small Breeds Working Hunter Pony

To be shown in natural state 55cm

Classes 20 – 26 may be judges as one round dependant on entries, manners etc will be scored during jumping phase.

Ring Five (Show Jumping)

Class 43 10.00 am

POLES ON THE FLOOR Excellent for those maybe just in the ring for the first time, wanting a pop round a track of fences and some confidence. Everyone starts from the ground up ! Help on hand if needed. Rosettes for all competitors. Entries may not compete beyond 55 cms

Class 44 10.30 am

JUMPS NOT EXC 45 CMS Nice easy flowing course for our beginners, the ring will be supersized, inviting jumps and no fillers Excellent class if you're just starting out jumping or bringing a youngster on. Rosettes for all competitors. Help on hand if needed. Entries may not compete beyond Pairs

Class 45 11.00 am

JUMPS NOT EXC 55 CMS Entries may not compete beyond 65 cms A real fun class over a full sized course and NO fillers yeah !

Class 46 12.00 pm

Mums and Dads SJ JUST FOR FUN Over a course of jumps which absolutely will not exceed 55 cms lots of fun for those usually encouraging from the ringside. 'Age appropriate' goody bags to top six in this class. This class will be a regular in our sj ring.

Class 47

Pairs over X Poles Both riders will jump a full course against the clock. Much cheering encouragement from the ringside is an absolute must in this class.

Class 48

1.00 pm JUMPS NOT EXC 65 CMS Entries may not compete beyond 85 cms Class will be split Horses and Ponies.

Class 49

1.30 pm JUMPS NOT EXC 75 CMS Class will be split horses /ponies Sashes to both winners & Platinum Jubilee Rosettes

Class 50

Accumulator 65 - 75 cms Class will be split horses /ponies Jump as many fences as you can in 60 seconds, then opt to attempt our joker fence to boost your score. He who dares !

Class 51

2.30 pm JUMPS NOT EXC 85 cms Class will be split horses /ponies

Class 52 JUMPS NOT EXC 95 CMS Class will be split horses /ponies Winners of each section to receive SUPER SIZED rosettes plus Fizz

Classes apart from 46 and 47 will be split horses and ponies.

Times stated are as a guide only and may be subject to change, dependent on entries.

Advance entries ensures you will be allocated a time at which you'll jump.

Rosettes to sixth place in all classes
