Competitors, please note although this is an affiliated competition it will be run to British dressage rules. CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- 1. It is a requirement of the BHS that anybody mounted at a show ground must wear a hat of the minimum standards or BSI 1384 or PAS015 this must be correctly secured with a harness fixed at three or more points anyone failing to comply with this rule will be asked to leave the show ground.
- 2. Objections must be lodged within 15 minutes of the close of the class and be accompanied by a deposit of £20 which will be refunded if the objections upheld.
- 3. The organisers on committee reserves the right to alter or cancel any class at their discretion and request any competitor to remove from the competition any animal that is thought to be unfit to compete for any reason whatsoever their decision is final.
- 4. All horse and ponies must be four years older old on 1st Jan this year
- 5. Owners entering horses or ponies do so entirely at their own risk West Yorkshire Horseplay officials, committee members and stewards accept no liability of any kind in respect of accident damage injury illness to horses ponies owners grooms ground spectator or any other person or property whatsoever.
- 6. The organiser the event have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure that health and safety to everyone present. For these measures to be effective everyone must take all responsible precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organisers and stewards.
