Rules and Regulations

Smart appearance in the ring at all times

The organisers reserve the right to alter or cancel any classes and to refuse entry on to the showground

The Judges decision is final

Whips must not exceed 30 inches in length

The correct standard of hat must be worn with a chin strap at all times when mounted unless the competitor signs a disclaimer at the secretary office.

Horse or ponies under the age of 4 years old must not be ridden on the showground

Dogs are welcome but must be kept on a lead

No mucking out of horseboxes on the showground

Please take your rubbish home with you or use the bins provided

Stallions and colts welcome but must be handled by a competent person

Refunds are only given if we cancel a class, we do not give refunds if a competitor withdraws from a class

ALL horses have to have full vaccinations upto date and have to be 7 days clear if a second vaccination. All passports have to be checked before the horses leave their transport - there is no exception

In Hand Classes – Starts 9.30

Ring 1

Class 1 Youngstock – 1, 2, 3 years old

Class 2 Best Gelding – may be split between horses and ponies if sufficient entries

Class 3 Best Cob/Heavy Type – can be shown natural, plaited or hogged

Class 4 Best Riding horse, Hack or ROR in hand

Class 5 Bonny Pony

Class 6 Best Handler– may split between seniors and juniors if sufficient entries

Class 7 Partbred – may be shown natural, plaited or hogged

Class 8 Condition Regardless of Flaws – Judged purely on confirmation and going regardless of any scars or blemishes

In Hand Championship for all 1sts and 2nds

There will be a 30 minute break for the judge prior to the ridden classes commencing. Ridden classes will not commence before 12pm

Ridden Classes – All ridden will be in the full 65m x 35m indoor arena

Class 16 First Ridden inc Lead Rein – judged separate - lead rein must be attached to the nose band, child 12 years and under, to be ridden in a snaffle.

Class 17 Promising Newcomer – open to horses and ponies that are 4, 5 and 6 years old

Class 18 Absolute Beginners – open to horse/pony, rider any age, inc lead rein. No group canter and canter optional in individual show

Class 19 Novice Ridden – open to horses/ponies. Combination not to have won 1st in previous season. No group canter

Class 20 Ideal Partners – judged on manners, performance and compatability

Class 21 Mountain and Moorland – may be split between large and small

In Hand Classes – Starts 9.30

Ring 2

Class 9 Veteran – 15 years and over

Class 10 Best Mare – may be split between horses and ponies if sufficient entries

Class 11 Mountain and Moorland – may split between large and small breeds

Class 12 Shetland or Miniature Horse– full or miniature

Class 13 Best Condition – may split between horses and ponies if sufficient entries

Class 14 Best coloured – piebald, skewbald, roan, dun, cremello, palomino, spotted

Class 15 Novice – combination not to have won 3 1st places in previous season

In Hand Championship for all 1sts and 2nds

There will be a 30 minute break for the judge prior to the ridden classes commencing. Ridden classes will not commence before 12pm

Ridden Classes – All ridden will be in the full 65m x 35m indoor arena
