Class 6 Veteran Horse / Pony Age to be displayed. 15 years and over. VHS Area & VHPRC qualifier.

-Judge's Break -

Class 7 Coloured Horse/Pony To include piebald, skewbald, Appaloosa, palomino, spotted or dun.

Class 8 Mature Rider over 35 years No jumping required, judged on position, balance and effectiveness of aids rather than the horse's confirmation and paces. VHPRC qualifier.

Class 9 Mountain & Moorland. Class will be split (if numbers permit) into:

M&M small breeds Exmoors, Dartmoors, Shetlands, Welsh Sec A & B.

M&M large breeds Highlands, Fells, Dales, New Forest, Connemara, Welsh Sec C & D. Need not be registered but must be true to type.

Class 10 Ridden Cob To include all cob types, registered and non-registered. **Class 11 Thoroughbred** Open to horses bred to race, trained, have raced or retired racehorses. ROR registered horses will be eligible for ROR League Points. **Class 12 Ridden Hunter / Riding Horse** Mare or gelding ex.148 cm.

First round qualifier for the Veteran Horse Society Supreme Final: **VETERAN HORSE OF THE YEAR 2022** Kindly Sponsored by Allen & Page.

Open to members and non-members. All competitors and grooms must adhere to VHS Rules in all circumstances. Failure to do so may result in immediate disqualification.

VHS Regional Final qualification. All competitors placed 1st to 4th in each Area Qualifier class will qualify for the corresponding class at VHS Regional Finals. Members must carry their card in the ring at all times and have their showing card signed by the judge as proof of qualification. Non-members will receive a red qualification card which can be exchanged for signed showing card when applying for VHS membership, this MUST be done within 21 days of qualification. It is the competitors responsibility to present their Showing card to the judge.

Regional Finals are open to members only.

All competitors are eligible to enter open classes at the National Veteran Championships, to be held at Arena UK Lincolnshire on 30th September – 2nd October 2022. No qualification or membership necessary. See VHS website for schedule.

- 3. Correctly fitted footwear and headgear that conform to the current safety standard must be worn at all times when mounted.
- 4. No galloping allowed on the showground
- 5. Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times
- 6. In the event of cancellation, your entry fee will be carried over to the next Tumpy Green event. No Refunds given.
- 7. A vet's or doctor's certificate will be required if a withdrawal is made and request for a refund given due to the incapacity of horse or rider
- 8. No jewellery to be worn and long hair to be secured above collar height.
- 9. No horse or pony under 4 years may compete in any ridden class.
- 10. Stallions and colts must be adequately bitted and handled by an adult.
- 11. Please abide by current social distancing guidelines.

Tumpy Green reserve the right to alter or cancel any event and to disqualify anyone from competing if they are guilty of unseemly conduct or dangerous riding. All competitors take part entirely at their own risk and the organisers do not hold themselves responsible for any incident or damage that may occur to horse, rider, property, vehicle or spectator.
