Warm up on grass - tests to be ridden on sand & rubber surface in an enclosed arena.

All tests to be judged by BD listed judge.

Prize to overall winner of the mini – league – you need to enter a minimum of four of the six competitions to be included in the league

Special rosette in each class for highest placed WSRC combination & trophy for WSRC overall winner of each section to be presented at AGM

Class 1 Walk & Trot BD Introductory B 2009 Class 2 BD Preliminary 7 2002 Class 3 BD Preliminary 14 2006

Rosettes: $1st - 6^{th}$ in each class and points towards mini-league prize. $1^{st} = 6$ points $2^{nd} = 5$ points $3^{rd} = 4$ points $4^{th} = 3$ points $5^{th} = 2$ points $6^{th} = 1$ point IF you enter more than one class, your overall highest points score from ONE class ONLY will count towards mini league.

ENTRIES: will be strictly limited in each class and on first come, first served basis.

PLEASE do NOT arrive at the venue more than ONE hour before your start time.

If you are attending the event alone, please clearly display EMERGENCY CONTACT details in the front of your vehicle.

Entries will be limited in each class.

All horses/ponies must be 4 years old or over.

No lunging allowed.

This competition will be run under British Riding Club Dressage Rules 2022. The judge's decision is final. Any competitor not adhering to the rules will be eliminated. Rules available online http://www.bhs.org.uk/enjoy-riding/british-riding-clubs/brc-handbook

ALL TESTS MAY BE CALLED.

No horse/pony may compete twice in the same class with different riders.

Competitors are advised to bring their horse passports, but these will not be checked.

It is the responsibility of individuals to familiarise themselves with the correct turnout requirements and permitted tack as detailed in BRC Rulebook 2022 - see link above. WSRC reserve the right to tack check all competitors.

Protective helmets to current safety standards as detailed in British Riding Club Rulebook 2022 must be worn at all times when mounted with chinstrap fastened.

Only the person competing the horse may ride it on site and in warm up. Only competing equines may attend the event unless it is a non-ridden companion. No tack to be used in the warm up which is not allowed in the competition.

The organisers reserve the right to alter/cancel classes at their discretion.

Please leave the area around your horsebox/trailer/vehicle clean and tidy – REMOVE ALL HAY AND DROPPINGS – PLEASE BRING own equipment and take hay and droppings home!

HORSES /PONIES MUST NOT BE TIED TO OUTSIDE OF HORSEBOXES AND LEFT UNATTENDED

Liability: Neither the landowners, organisers, nor any person acting on their behalf accept any liability for any loss, damage, accident, injury or illness to horses, riders, spectators or any other persons or property whatsoever.

The organiser of the event has taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the organisers and all the Officials and Stewards.

WSRC reserves the right to alter the schedule or advertised start time, refuse any entry, amalgamate classes and cancel any class should conditions be or become unsuitable.

Insurance whilst attending BRC events. Non-members are not covered by the BRC insurance policy. It is mandatory for anyone attending this event to have third party insurance. It is the rider's responsibility to ensure that if making an entry they do have the necessary third-party insurance in place.

Health and Safety: All who attend the event are responsible for ensuring that they conduct themselves so that they do not put themselves or anyone else at risk. Vehicles must be parked so as not to cause obstruction. Unmounted attendees are requested to keep clear of the warm up area and to avoid behaviour which may alarm horses.

ANYONE FAILING TO COMPLY WITH THE RULES OR HEALTH AND SAFETY WILL BE ASKED TO WITHDRAW - ABUSIVE BEHAVIOUR WILL NOT BE TOLERATED UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCES.

Please note there are no toilets and no refreshments at the venue - please bring with you EVERYTHING you need for you and your horse/pony.

Please do not bring dogs.

Due to ongoing COVID-19 restrictions and possible changes in government guidance, it may be necessary to amend how this event is run at a late stage. Any Covid Restrictions will be posted on WSRC Facebook page prior to the event, and by entering this event you agree to abide by any measure we may have to implement at a late stage.
