**SJ training competition run on sand & rubber surface in an enclosed arena**

Prize to overall winner of the mini – league and league rosettes 1<sup>st</sup> - 6<sup>th</sup> place at end of series

Trophy for WSRC member overall winner to be presented at AGM

Points towards mini-league prize and overall 1<sup>st</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> place end of series rosettes awarded as follows:

1<sup>st</sup> = 6 points 2<sup>nd</sup> = 5 points 3<sup>rd</sup> = 4 points 4<sup>th</sup> = 3 points 5<sup>th</sup> = 2 points 6<sup>th</sup> = 1 point

**ENTRIES:** will be strictly limited and on first come, first served basis

## SJ Training Competition Format

- 1) Choose your SJ height – with or without fillers – mark on entry form
- 2) Warm up & train with Andrea using round one (non jump off) fences ONLY
- 3) Take part in the competition by jumping round one fences again in course order (not timed) IMMEDIATELY followed by jump off course {same height as round one but will include some “new” fences that you haven’t practised! Your jump off round will be timed and the winner will be the pony/horse & rider combination with the lowest number of faults over the two rounds. In the event of a tie, jump off round times will be used to decide the results.

PLEASE do NOT arrive at the venue more than ONE hour before your start time.

If you are attending the event alone, please clearly display EMERGENCY CONTACT details in the front of your vehicle.

Entries will be limited in each class.

All horses/ponies must be 4 years old or over. **No lunging allowed.**

**This training competition will be run under British Riding Club SJ Rules 2022. The trainer's decision is final.**

**Any competitor not adhering to the rules will be eliminated. Rules available online**

No horse/pony may compete twice with different riders.

Competitors are advised to bring their horse passports, but these will not be checked.

**It is the responsibility of individuals to familiarise themselves with the correct turnout requirements and permitted tack as detailed in BRC Rulebook 2022 - see link above. WSRC reserve the right to tack check all competitors. You do not need to wear competition dress but hats, body protectors (if worn) and footwear must comply with BRC rules 2022.**

Protective helmets to current safety standards as detailed in British Riding Club Rulebook 2022 must be worn at all times when mounted with chinstrap fastened.

**Only the person competing the horse may ride it on site and in warm up. Only competing equines may attend the event unless it is a non-ridden companion. No tack to be used in the warm up which is not allowed in the competition.**

The organisers reserve the right to alter/cancel the SJ training competition at their discretion.

**Please leave the area around your horsebox/trailer/vehicle clean and tidy – REMOVE ALL HAY AND DROPPINGS – PLEASE BRING own equipment and take hay and droppings home!**

**HORSES /PONIES MUST NOT BE TIED TO OUTSIDE OF HORSEBOXES AND LEFT UNATTENDED**

**Liability:** Neither the landowners, organisers, nor any person acting on their behalf accept any liability for any loss, damage, accident, injury or illness to horses, riders, spectators or any other persons or property whatsoever.

The organiser of the event has taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the organisers and all the Officials and Stewards.

WSRC reserves the right to alter the schedule or advertised start time, refuse any entry, amalgamate classes and cancel any class should conditions be or become unsuitable.

**Insurance whilst attending BRC events.** Non-members are not covered by the BRC insurance policy. It is mandatory for anyone attending this event to have third party insurance. It is the rider's responsibility to ensure that if making an entry they do have the necessary third-party insurance in place.

**Health and Safety:** All who attend the event are responsible for ensuring that they conduct themselves so that they do not put themselves or anyone else at risk. Vehicles must be parked so as not to cause obstruction. Unmounted attendees are requested to keep clear of the warm up area and to avoid behaviour which may alarm horses.

**ANYONE FAILING TO COMPLY WITH THE RULES OR HEALTH AND SAFETY WILL BE ASKED TO WITHDRAW - ABUSIVE BEHAVIOUR WILL NOT BE TOLERATED UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCES.**

**Please note there are no toilets and no refreshments at the venue - please bring with you EVERYTHING you need for you and your horse/pony. Please do not bring dogs.**

Due to ongoing COVID-19 restrictions and possible changes in government guidance, it may be necessary to amend how this event is run at a late stage. Any Covid Restrictions will be posted on WSRC Facebook page prior to the event, and by entering this event you agree to abide by any measure we may have to implement at a late stage.
