CLASS 2 British Native

Open to all registered & unregistered British breeds (where breed originated from)

- (a) Small Breeds (Shetland, Dartmoor, Exmoor, Welsh A & B
- (b) Large Breeds (Dale, Fell, Highland, New Forest, Welsh C&D, Suffolk Punch, Shire, Clydesdale, Thoroughbred

CLASS 3 Non British Native

Open to all registered & unregistered non-British Breeds (Haflinger, Fjord, Arab, Warm bloods, Connemara, Irish Drafts, etc)

CLASS 4 Coloured

Open to all Skewbald, Piebald, Spotted, Roan, Dun & Palomino

CLASS 5 Cobs

Open to all cob types - hairy legs, flowing manes and tails

CLASS 6 Solid Colour

Open to all horses/ponies of a solid colour - Chestnut, Black, Brown, Bay, Grey

CLASS 7 Veteran

Open to all horses & ponies 16 yo and over (passports may be checked) Special rosette for best 20+ horse/pony

RULES & CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- It shall be deemed a condition of entry that Mortimer Riding Club, persons acting on their behalf, or their agents, or the landowners shall not be held responsible for any loss, injury, accident, damage or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators or any other person whatsoever whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract or in any way whatsoever. The Committee recommend that all riders have adequate Personal, Third Party and Horse Insurance
- Everyone mounted whether a competitor or not MUST wear protective headgear that
 includes a permanently fitted, non-detachable retaining harness secured to the shell at more
 than two points. Such headgear must be worn with the harness properly adjusted and
 fastened at all times. A riding hat complying with BS6473 or a skull cap BS4472 is the
 compulsory minimum required, however British Riding Clubs recommend that the PAS015
 standard or equivalent be worn
- The Organisers reserve the right to alter or cancel the event or any of the published information
- In the event of an objection the Secretary's decision is final
- No refund of entry fees will be made except on receipt of a Doctor's or Veterinary Surgeon's certificate
- No horse or pony under 4yo may be ridden at the event
- No stallions or dogs
- No cantering, lunging or long reining on the Fairground
- Please observe care in the parking area and always follow any instructions given.
- No skipping out. Leave the area tidy and clear of horse droppings when you leave
- First Aid is 999/112 call only, so people attend at their own risk
- The Secretary may require to see Horse Passports, so please have them available on the day
- All Children mounted or not are the responsibility of their Parent/Guardian at all times
- All mounted riders are to be 4yo or over at the time of the event and must be accompanied by an adult with the horse/pony on a lead rein
- Handlers must be 8yo or over, or are to be accompanied in the ring by an adult (18yo or over)
- Competition clothes must be worn with appropriate footwear. No jeans
