5. Every horse or pony to have current in date Flu vaccinations. Booster within 12 months.
6. The decision of the judge is final and no objections shall be entertained
7. All droppings by your box to be picked up and taken home.
8. No dogs allowed
9. The organisers retain the right to disqualify any competitor for any cruelty or discourteousness.
10. Horses/ponies cannot compete more than once in each class.
11. No horse or pony under the age of four and no stallions may compete unless with the express permission of the event organiser.
12. Hard hats to current pony club standards must be worn with the chin strap fastened when mounted at all times.
13. It is advised that back protectors are worn when jumping.
14. The age of the rider to be that on the day of the show.
15. The lunging or riding of horses/ponies in bearing, check or balancing reins is not permitted.
16. The organisers reserve the right to cancel and/or amend any of the classes as they feel fit or to alter advertised times or refuse entry without stating reason.
17. All classes are ridden unless stated otherwise.
