CLASSES ARE £8 FOR MEMBERS AND £10 FOR NON-MEMBERS.

TGCA Breed classes are qualifiers for the Best of Breed Finals at the Traditional Gypsy Cob Association's (TGCA) National Breed Championship Show "TOYS". Classes are open to all traditional gypsy cobs. Part Bred classes, are open to all part bred traditional gypsy cobs and are qualifiers for the part bred finals at "TOYS". The exhibit must have one parent that is bred traditional gypsy cob. Stallions – All stallions (four years and over) in order to enter any TGCA affiliated class MUST be TGCA registered, have passed TGCA stallion evaluations and their TGCA stallion disc displayed on their bridle. Stallions and colts over the age of two, MUST be shown in a stallion bridle with a metal bit and chain lead as per the current TGCA rulebook. Current TGCA members must present their Membership card and Qualification card to the judge in the ring for signature. Non-members MUST receive a qualification card from the judge and have 21 days to join the TGCA and register their horse to validate the qualification. This show is a qualifier for the TSR Showing Finals. All In Hand & Ridden classes are qualifiers.

You Do Not have to be a TSR member to qualify or enter a final.

The Rider/Handler qualifies and can enter any horse/pony in any number of Finals!

The 4 highest placed handlers/riders will qualify in each class.

Both owner and the rider/exhibitor need NOT be a member of CHAPS (UK) nor must the horse or pony be registered with CHAPS (UK) to compete. However, in order to qualify both owner and rider/exhibitor need to be a current member and have a valid qualifier card. Members to apply in to CHAPS (UK) for appropriate qualifier card.

open in hand piebald / skewbald stallion, mare, colt, filly or gelding, any age. the first three places will also qualify for the bspa championships. subject to their show rules & conditions.

classes may be divided according to entries.

CLASS 2. NATIVE/COB/TRADITIONAL OPEN

any age. no foals

(class may be split upon entries taken)

CLASS 3. YOUNGSTOCK

open to any type exhibit; yearlings, 2 or 3 year olds.

top 3 qualify for tgca

CLASS 4. SHOW PONY/HORSE - BEST TURNED OUT

class may be split accordingly

CLASS 5. VETERANS

Open to all exhibits age 15 yrs and over.

CLASS 6. UNUSUAL COLOURS

roans/palaminos/spotty/dun

CLASS 7. SPILLERS MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND INHAND PURE BRED – (EXCLUDING WELSH BREED)

** open to in hand mountain & moorland ponies registered with their respective pure bred societies of connemara, dales, dartmoor, exmoor, fell, highland, new forest, shetland, stallion,*

mare, colt, filly or gelding, any age.

this class may be divided as appropriate.

CLASS 8. PART BREDS – OPEN TO ALL BREEDS

(Class may be split upon entries taken)

CLASSES 1-8 1st & 2nd PLACE CHAMPIONSHIP THEN CHAMPION & RESERVE TO GO INTO SUPREME.

Rider any age. Open to all horses and ponies aged 15 and over. Any suitable bridle.

Class 18. RETRAINED RACEHORSE

Rider any age. Open to all ex-racehorses which are registered with ROR. Any suitable bridle.

Class 19. EQUIFEST OPEN RIDING HORSES

*open riding horse, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over. any height
riders any age. class may be divided if needed.*

Class 20. TACK & TURNOUT

Class 21. NATIVE/COB/TRADITIONAL OPEN RIDDEN QUALIFIER

Any Height. Class May be split.

Class 22. RIDDEN COLOURED - HOGGED AND PLAITED

Any Height. Class may be split accordingly.

Class 23. M&M - SMALL BREEDS – OPEN TO ALL AGES

*mares and geldings, 4 years old & over, registered in the respective
pure bred studbooks of dartmoor, exmoore, shetland
EXCLUDING WELSH A&B.*

Class 24. M&M - LARGE BREEDS

*mares and geldings, 4 years old & over
registered in the respective pure bred studbooks of connemara, fells, dales,
highlands, new forest. riders of large breeds not to have attained their
18th birthday before 1st january in the current year.
EXCLUDING WELSH C&D*

**CLASSES 17 - 24 1st & 2nd PLACE CHAMPIONSHIP THEN
CHAMPION & RESERVE TO GO INTO SUPREME.**

Class 25. M&M - LEAD REIN

*Rider not to have attained their 10th birthday before 1st January in the current year.
Ponies not to exceed 128cms. Any suitable bridle*

Class 26. CHAPS (UK) FIRST RIDDEN

*first ridden pony, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over. not exceeding 153cms
riders not to have attained their 10th birthday before 1st January in the
current year. to be shown in any suitable bridle.*

Class 27. EQUIFEST OPEN RIDDEN PART BREDS

*stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over. exhibits in this section must
be registered in the part bred section of their respective breed society
registration numbers must be stated on the entry form. horses and ponies
will not be ridden at the final. riders any age. classes may be divided.*

Class 28. WELSH A & B - TSR QUALIFIER

Class 29. NOVICE

*Open to any age of rider on any height of exhibit.
Not to have won more than 6 times (excluding novelty classes). Mare, Gelding or
Stallion. 4yrs of age & over.
WALK TROT CLASS ONLY.*

Class 30. WELSH C & D - TSR QUALIFIER

CLASS 31. BEST MARE – OPEN TO ALL MARES

CLASS 32. BEST GELDING – OPEN TO ALL GELDINGS

CLASS 33. RARE BREEDS – OPEN TO ALL RARE BREEDS
