CLEAR ROUNDS:

We will be running clear rounds over the old and new cross-country courses – enter on the day – payment in cash. £5 First Aid in addition to CR if not already paid as a competitor.

SCHEDULE

Class 1: MINI (May be Assisted) Fences approx. 25-30 cm

Assistance including leading rein may be given WITHOUT penalty. Suitable for all ages.

Water not included

Class 2: MINI PLUS Fences approx. 40cm Assistance may be given, although not suitable for lead rein.

Water in Class 2: The water can be missed; however you will incur 10 penalties. If you attempt the water and have any problems you will incur those penalties, in addition to the 10 penalties for missing the water.

Class 3: NOVICE Fences approx. 50cm (No Assistance allowed)

Eland Lodge Qualifier for 50cm Championship

Section A: Juniors (16 and Under on 1st January 2021). Section B: Seniors (Over 16 years)

Class 4: NOVICE PLUS Fences approx. 60cm (No Assistance allowed)

Pick and Mix Classes:

Riders must attempt one jump from each line of fences where all height are together (for example, the first log or the railway crossing), they may choose to jump other jumps of the height they choose. The easiest way to select your pick and mix track is to choose a height you would like to jump, follow that course and jump larger fences on the easy fences or select a smaller option on a more daunting fence.

Class 5: Mini PICK & MIX Fences approx. 40cm – 60cm (No Assistance allowed)

Riders can select any height of jump that is included in the 40cm, 50cm, or 60cm courses.

Class 6: Mini PICK & MIX PAIRS Fences approx. 40cm – 60cm (No Assistance allowed)

Riders can select any height of jump that is included in the 40cm, 50cm, or 60cm courses.

Water in Class 5 & 6: The water can be missed; however you will incur 10 penalties. If you attempt the water and have any problems you will incur those penalties, in addition to the 10 penalties for missing the water. In the Pairs class, each rider is marked separately, and will incur penalties accordingly.

Class 7: Maxi PICK & MIX Fences approx. 70cm-90cm (No Assistance allowed)

Riders can select any height of jump that is included in the 70cm, 80cm, or 85cm Plus courses.

Class 8: Maxi PICK & MIX PAIRS Fences approx. 70cm – 90cm (No Assistance allowed)

Riders can select any height of jump that is included in the 70cm, 80 or 85cm Plus courses.

Class 9: INTERMEDIATE Fences approx. 70cm (No Assistance allowed)

Eland Lodge Qualifier for 70cm Championship

Section A: Juniors (16 and Under on 1st January 2021). Section B: Seniors (Over 16 years)

Class 10: OPEN Fences approx. 80cm (No Assistance allowed)

Eland Lodge Qualifier for 80cm Championship

Section A: Juniors (16 and Under on 1st January 2021). Section B: Seniors (Over 16 years)

Class 11: OPEN PAIRS Fences approx. 80cm (No Assistance allowed)

Eland Lodge Qualifier for 80cm Pairs Championship

Class 12: OPEN PLUS Fences approx. 85cm (No Assistance allowed)

Eland Lodge Qualifier for the 90cm Championship

Section A: Juniors (16 and Under on 1st January 2021). Section B: Seniors (Over 16 years)

The Water in Classes 3-11 (Except classes 5 & 6): Fully included as part of the course and will incur penalties in line with all other fences.

A and B Sections are solely for qualification purposes. Sections will be combined for placings.

All Hunter Trial classes will include a clearly marked fastest time section

The timed section may include knockdown fences or a gate to negotiate. If knocked down 10 penalties will be incurred for each jump. The knockdown fences will be positioned side by side, each rider must jump a different one of the knockdown jumps. A maximum of 20 penalties can therefore be incurred.

CLOSING DATE: The Wednesday before the competition. If classes are full before the closing date, then a waiting list will be held. Start Time: Class 1, will not start before 12.30pm

TIMES: Start lists with times will be on Tumpy Green Equestrian Centre's Facebook page; by the evening of Friday before the competition.

PRIZEGIVING: Class presentations will take place approximately 30 minutes after each class. Rosettes: to sixth place in each class.

NUMBER BIBS: Number bib holders will be required to display the provided numbers.

DISCLAIMERS

1. Entries are only accepted on this basis.
2. The organisers of this event have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present at this event. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents. They must obey the instructions of the organisers and all officials and stewards.
3. All non Pony Club competitors are not covered by The Pony Club insurance and must have their own third party cover. The Tumpy Green Branch of The Pony Club and the organisers of this event are not legally responsible for non-Members and their insurance will not cover them.

RULES AND NOTICES

1. Substitutions allowed – please tell the Secretary (Entries before the day, Show on the day). All changes must be on the day once the times have been published.
2. Pre-entries are essential as entries will be limited. If you miss the closing date please ring/ email the Entries Secretary for available spaces.
3. Closing date for entries – Wednesday before the competition. Withdrawal refunds given on receipt of a relevant doctor/vet certificate received by the Entries Secretary within a week of the competition (please enclose an s.a.e.)
4. If the show is cancelled due to circumstances beyond our control, entry fees will be help in credit for a future event. Any refund will be subject to an administration fee.
5. TIMES WILL BE GIVEN – please see the Tumpy Green Facebook page. Competitors may be asked to jump up to 15 minutes before their given time – please be ready.
6. Warm-up Arena – the number of competitors may be restricted; please obey the steward's instructions as to when you can use the warm-up. No one will be allowed to enter the warm-up arena without a number or until the First Aid and entry fees have been paid. Children must not ride in the warm-up arena without an accompanying adult.
7. Each combination may only compete once in any given class. Stallions are allowed only with prior permission from the Entries Secretary and must wear stallion discs and ribbons. All horse/ponies must be at least 4 years old on day of competition.
8. Any abuse of horses/ponies, officials, other competitors or members of the public will not be tolerated and those found doing so will be asked to leave the venue with no compensation and may be reported to the relevant authority.
9. Judges' decision is final. Any objection must be handed to the Show Secretary in writing with a £20 deposit (which will be forfeited if the objection is not upheld) within 15 minutes of the incident and BEFORE the prize-giving for that class.
10. INSURANCE; please ensure that you have adequate/appropriate insurance for rider, horse, property and third party.
11. PHOTOGRAPHS: by entering this competition you are agreeing to be photographed whilst competing; these photographs may be used for future publicity. If you do not wish to be photographed please tell the photographer on entering the arena, before you jump.
12. Participants attend at their own risk; neither the Committee nor Tumpy Green Competition Centre will be liable for any loss, damage or accident to horses, riders, property or other persons.
13. No horses/ponies should be left tied to the outside of trailers/lorries without supervision. Please clear any muck/rubbish and do not leave on the lorry park. Please be aware that there is no gate between the lorry park and the main road. All hay must be collected and removed from the lorry park.
14. The show will be run under The Pony Club Eventing Rules 2022 – including tack and dress code.
15. Please abide by social distancing guidelines by maintaining 1m apart, providing any monies in a sealed envelope, parking as instructed and restricting numbers in each warm-up area to 4 combinations.
16. No hat or body cameras will be allowed to be worn on whilst mounted on the show grounds.
