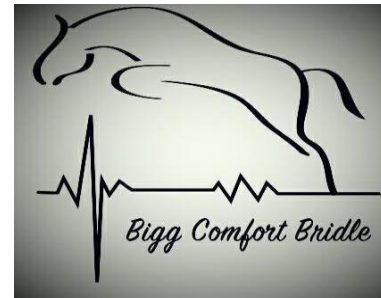

**PLEASE NOTE –**

1. Competitors may only enter Restricted or Open within each class.
2. Scores over 63% in each class will qualify for the championship class in October.
3. In all classes restricted and open sections will be run together but scored separately.
4. No competitor may ride more than 2 consecutive levels on the same horse unless it is HC.
5. You can enter both Novice classes, these will be judged separately.
6. You cannot enter both tests with the same horse in Class 4 PYO.

## GENERAL CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. No liability shall fall on the Organisers, Landowners, Judges or Officials in respect of any loss, damage or injury howsoever caused and all competitors are deemed to be liable to indemnify the said persons in respect of any such loss, damage or injury.
2. Every effort will be made to keep to the schedules, but we reserve the right to alter the order and composition of classes or to cancel them.
3. Any competitor may be warned or disqualified for improper or excessive use of whips, spurs etc. or other actions which the Judges or Officials consider warrants such penalty.
4. Correct riding attire must be worn at all times with the exception of those wearing fancy dress. ALL RIDERS, whether competing or not, must wear the correct headgear; PAS 015 (1998/2011) or BSEN 1384 with a kitemark or prefixed ASTM or SEI are the minimum standard but riders have to be responsible for their own safety. Failure to wear correct headgear will incur elimination.
5. The ruling of the judges is final. All complaints must be put in writing and handed to the secretary with a deposit of £10 within 15 minutes of the incident, returnable if the objection is upheld.
6. Entries may be refused without reason being given and there will be no entitlement to any refund of entry unless a class is cancelled due to insufficient entries, or a Medical/Veterinary Certificate is produced. Up to 25% of entry money may be retained to cover administration costs.
7. Change of horse or rider must be notified to the Secretary 15 minutes before the start of the class or the entry will become void for the Open classes. Change of horse and rider will **not be** accepted in the Championship classes.
8. ALL DOGS must be kept on leads at all times.
9. Rosettes will be awarded to sixth place.
10. Horses and ponies must be 4 years or older to compete.
11. It is the responsibility of competitors to know the rules - our stewards and officials are there to help and advise. Please remember all our helpers are volunteers.
12. Riders who fall off during the competition continue riding entirely at their own risk.
