Each competitor jumps approximately 7 show jumps and then immediately goes on and jumps 7-10 cross country fences finishing over 1 show jump.

These competitions are aimed at the new, novice and /or nervous rider of any age. The aim is to give riders a supportive gentle introduction to cross country riding. Please enter in the spirit of this.

- **ROSETTES** All riders will receive a completion rosette at each event.
- **AWARDS** Each combination must complete a minimum of 2 of the 3 competitions to gain one of the below awards:
 - Bronze Award - Combination has competed at a minimum of 2 of the 3 competitions and completed all the rounds entered.
 - Silver Award - Combination has competed at a minimum of 2 of the 3 competitions and gone clear at least once.
 - Gold Award - Combination has competed at a minimum of 2 of the 3 competitions and has gone clear every time and is close to the optimum time (NOT SPEED!)
- **OPTIMALTIME** -Optimum time will be set based on a rhythmical round appropriate to level.



Rules

Entries are accepted and admission granted only subject to the following conditions, and it is a condition of entry that these have been accepted by each competitor.

All classes will be run in accordance with Pony Club Eventing Rule Book 2022 and the Pony Club Show jumping Rule Book 2022. You can view the rules at <u>www.pcuk.org</u>.

Organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organisers and all the officials and stewards.

Legal Liability Save for the death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers, or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of this event or The Pony Club nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies, nor the landlord or his tenant, accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars, their contents and accessories, or any other person or property whatsoever. Entries are only accepted on this basis.

The Judge's decision is final, and any objections must be accompanied by £25 deposit which will be returned if upheld. Horse/Pony must be 4 years or over on day of show. All dogs must be kept on lead.

The Organisers reserve the right to refuse entry without stating a reason and to eliminate any competitor who in their opinion places themselves or others in danger or fails to observe the rules.

All competitors **MUST** wear a body protector. Please check pony club rules for details

All competitors must wear a hat to current British Standards and be Pony Club checked and tagged.

No jewellery allowed.

All Non Pony Club riders MUST have their own insurance
