CLASSES

IN HAND CLASSES - 9.30am Judge Mr Michael Goddard (Bewcastle)

Class 1: Novice In hand Pony – Any age, never to have a won a FIRST prize. (This class is designed for totally novice ponies who need experience in the ring – PLEASE DO NOT ABUSE THIS – Thank you)

1st & 2nd place winners eligible for relevant age championship

Class 2: Stallions (4 years plus must be fully licensed and bitted)

Class 3: Two & Three year old colts (All must be bitted)

Class 4: Yearling Colt, Filly or Gelding

Class 5: Two Year Old Filly or Gelding

Class 6: Three Year Old Filly or Gelding

Class 7: Mares without foal at foot, 4 years and over

Class 8: Mare with foal at foot

Class 9: Foal (To be at least 3 weeks old on Show day and eligible for registration in the main section of the Fell Pony Stud Book)

Class 10: Geldings, 4 years and over

Class 11: Veteran (15 years and over)

GROUP CLASSES:

NB Ponies must have pre-entered the show in other classes to compete. Owners of ponies must be current members of the FPS irrespective of who exhibits or handles the ponies.

Class 12: Progeny – Best group (minimum of two) of Registered Ponies by the same Sire, Mare or same stud prefix. Entry Fee £5.00 per pony or £6.00 per pony if entered on the day.

Special A Youngstock Championship (1st & 2nd Prize winners from Classes, 3, 4, 5, 6 & 9

FPS Breed Rosette: Awarded to Youngstock Champion (Owner of pony to be a current FPS member)

Special B Adult Championship (1st & 2nd Prize winners from Classes 2, 7, 8, 10 & 11) **FPS Breed Rosette:** Awarded to Adult Champion (Owner of ponies to be a current FPS member)

JUNIOR HANDLER CLASSES: (Following conclusion of In hand Championship) Judge: TBC

13: Ages 4-10 years old (may have an accompanying Adult but only for safety reasons, not to help) 14: Ages 11-18 years old

RIDDEN CLASSES

Class 15: Novice Pony in its first season under saddle (Snaffle bridles only – Wilkies are acceptable) Class 16: Novice Pony not to have won a 1st prize of £10 before Jan 1st 2024 (Snaffle bridles only – Wilkies are acceptable)

Class 17: Traditional Ridden Class (Walk and Trot only)

Class 18: Open Ridden Class

Class 19. Veteran Ridden (15 years or over)

Special C Ridden Championship (1st & 2nd prize winners from classes 15, 16, 17, 18 and 19) **FPS Breed Rosette:** Awarded to Ridden Champion (Owner of ponies to be a current FPS member)

<u>Overall Supreme Championship</u> (Champion & Reserve Youngstock, Champion and Reserve Adult In Hand, Champion and Reserve Ridden Pony).
