**Qualifying details:**

\*SMS Qualification: Anyone placing 1<sup>st</sup> – 6<sup>th</sup> in the April or June shows directly qualifies to compete in our championship classes in December; championship sashes and rosettes will be awarded.

\*SMS League: Anyone placing 1<sup>st</sup> – 6<sup>th</sup> in the April or June show will gain points (6 for 1<sup>st</sup>, 5 for 2<sup>nd</sup>, 4 for 3<sup>rd</sup>, 3 for 4<sup>th</sup>, 2 for 5<sup>th</sup> and 1 for 6<sup>th</sup>); the rider with the highest amount of points will be awarded a rosette at the December show.

\*Trailblazers: 1<sup>st</sup> round = scores over 58% qualify for the 2<sup>nd</sup> round (Note qualifying cards need to be purchased)

2<sup>nd</sup> round = Combinations achieving a top 7 place will qualify for the championships

Juniors (16 and under)

Seniors can qualify at Intro, Prelim, Novice or Elementary.

Juniors can qualify at Intro, Prelim or Novice. A Junior rider may compete in Senior Elementary if aged 12 or over.





## GENERAL RULES AND CONDITIONS

1. Everyone mounted, whether competitor or not, shall wear a hard hat to at least the minimum standard PAS 015 (2011) or VG1, with a harness properly adjusted and fastened. Failure to do so will incur elimination.
2. Long hair should be worn in a net or secured in such a way as not to hang lower than the shoulder line.
3. Gloves are compulsory for dressage
4. A horse or pony may compete from 1 Jan in the year that it becomes 4 years old.
5. The organisers reserve the right to cancel the event, alter classes, times or any other published information. In the event of cancellation all fees will be refunded less 15%
6. Unless explicitly stated to the contrary, medical facilities on the showground will be limited to standard NHS accident and emergency callout
7. Entry fees are non-refundable unless an official doctor note or vet report is sent to the organiser
8. The judges decision is final both in the warm up and competition

SMS Equestrian, the organisers of the competition, and the landowners, accept **NO LIABILITY** for damage or injury to persons, animals or property, however caused. All entrants and their supporters must be aware that liability for accidents, however caused, may fall on them.

**This show is a qualifier for The Sunshine Tour Championships** held at **The All-England Showground, Hickstead** from **12<sup>th</sup> – 15<sup>th</sup> September 2024**. The Championships are for unaffiliated and amateur competitors in **Dressage** from Intro to Elementary, **Show Jumping** from Lead Rein to 1m; **Showing** for lead rein, in-hand, ridden, working hunter, veterans, plus many more, **Eventer's Challenge** from 50cm through to 90cm.

**Qualification: Dressage & Show Jumping 1<sup>st</sup> – 3<sup>rd</sup> place; Showing & Eventers Challenge 1<sup>st</sup> – 4<sup>th</sup> place.** Qualification does not pass down the line.
