No Stallions but Colts up to 3 years old allowed if handled by competent handler over 16.  
No galloping on the show field  
No Horses/Ponies under the age of 4 Years Old to be ridden on the show field.  
No mucking out of Horseboxes on the show field.  
Dogs to be always kept on a lead. Please take your rubbish home.
