RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- 1. The organisers reserve the right to refuse, amend or cancel any entry, class or the event at their discretion without giving reason.
- 2. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by the correct fee. Cheques will be cashed prior to the event. Only cash payments will be accepted for entries on the day.
- 3. No entry fee will be refunded except on production of a valid vet's certificate.
- 4. Horses/Ponies may only enter once per class.
- 5. All horse and ponies competing under saddle must be aged 4 years or over.
- 6. Any combination judged to be entered into a class for which they are not eligible will be disqualified or may be moved to another class at the judge's discretion.
- 7. Where age limits apply to horse or rider competitors may be asked to produce proof of age and failure to produce such may result in disqualification.
- 8. Any change of horse or rider must be notified to the secretary at least 15 minutes before the start of the class.
- 9. In the event of insufficient class entries lower rosettes and prizes may be withheld.
- 10. Any prizes or prize money won must be collected from the secretary and signed for before the end of the show. Prizes and prize money will not be held over.
- 11. Correctly fitted hard hats to PAS015 with BSI kitemark, VG1 01.0404 with BSI kitemark, ASTM F1163 with SEI mark, SNELL E2001, AS/NZS 3838 with SAI Global Mark with 3 point fastening secured and correct footwear (jodhpur boots or long riding boots) must be worn by anyone riding on the showground.
- 12. Back protectors are recommended for jumping but not compulsory.
- 13. Any rider wearing spurs must do so in the correct way. Any competitor found with their spurs the wrong way up (facing in the upward direction) will be disqualified.
- 14. Excessive use of the whip will lead to disqualification.
- 15. The judge's decision is final in all matters.
- 16. All competitors take part at their own risk. The organisers will not be held responsible for any accident that may occur to any horse, pony, rider, spectator or property and no claims can be entertained in connection with or arising from this event. It is a condition of entry that each competitor will indemnify the organisers against any legal action.
- 17. The organisers have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organisers, officials and stewards. Any accident, however small, must be reported and recorded in the secretary's office.
- 18. No one should allow a stallion for which he/she is responsible on the showground without taking adequate precautions to ensure members of the public and their animals are not put at risk of injury.
- 19. All dogs must be on leads and kept under control at all times.
- 20. Any animal not sufficiently under control shall be removed from the showground immediately at the request of the secretary, judge or stewards.
- 21. Anyone reported for cruelty to any animal or discourteous behaviour towards the organisers, judge, stewards or members of the public may be asked to leave the showground.
- 22. All children remain the responsibility of the parents and/or guardians at all times and no responsibility is accepted by the organisers.
- 23. Please do not leave your horses/ponies left tied up to the side of the trailers or lorries unattended.
- 24. No mucking out of trailers or lorries is allowed on the showground. All muck and loose hay or bedding must be gathered up and taken home.
- 25. Any complaints must be made in writing and handed to the organiser of the event within 15 minutes of the incident, accompanied by a deposit of £15 which will be refunded if the complaint is upheld.
