


From the East

IRISH DRAUGHT HORSE SOCIETY (GB)

GENERAL ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

All horses must be registered with or over-stamped by the IDHS (GB) and in the correct ownership **NEW**: Owners of Pure bred Irish Draughts **and** Irish Draught Sport Horses/Part bred) must now be full members of the IDHS (GB) to compete

Irish Draught Sport Horses/Part bred are horses that have a minimum of 25% proven Irish Draught breeding MARES with foals at foot, 3 years and over must be inspected and classified as Class I (or RID), Class 2 or Supplementary Grade Up (or AID)

Pure bred ID and ID Sport Horse / Part bred, 3 year old colts must be un-inspected

All 1, 2 & 3 year old colts must be bitted and shown by experienced handlers over 18 years of age

All pure-bred Irish Draught Stallions must be inspected and over-stamped by the IDHS (GB) and be Class 1, 2 or RID (GB).

Stallions must display a red, white and blue ribbon in their tails and be shown by experienced rider/handlers over 18 years of age

Ridden horses must be 153cm (15hh) or over.

GENERAL QUALIFIER INFORMATION

The Finals of all IDHS (GB) qualifiers will be held at the IDHS (GB) National Championship Show on 6th & 7th September 2025 at Onley Equestrian Centre, Onley Grounds Farm, Willoughby, Rugby, Warwickshire CV23 8AJ. All owners of qualified horses will be contacted by a member of the IDHS (GB) Show Affiliation Team Horses can only qualify for a specific Final once, regardless of the type or number of classes won, placed in or entered Please see respective qualifying classes for relevant details of the Finals

This show is a qualifier for **The Irish Draught Owners & Breeders Group Youngstock Challenge**. The two highest placed Pure Breds from each age group not already qualified in **Class 44** will qualify. If one or both have already qualified, the horse next in line in each age group will qualify. Horses entered into this class must be eligible under the criteria listed on page 6 of this schedule. At the final, there will be three preliminary classes with the two highest placed semi-finalists from each class going forward to the Championship.

The Champion will receive £500 and the Reserve Champion £150

- Irish Draught Yearling filly, gelding or colt, by a Class I, 2 or RID (GB) sire out of an inspected dam

This show is a qualifier for **The IDHS (GB) Sport Horse / Part Bred Youngstock Challenge**. The two highest placed Sport Horse / Part Breds (must have a minimum of 25% proven ID breeding) from each age group, not already qualified in **Class 45** will qualify. If one or both have already qualified, the horse next in line in each age group will qualify. Horses entered into this class must be eligible under the criteria listed on page 6 of this schedule. At the final, there will be three preliminary classes with the two highest placed semi-finalists from each class going forward to the Championship. The Champion will receive £500 and the Reserve Champion £150.



The highest placed horse (not already qualified) from each of the following **Classes (19 - 26, 36, 37, 38 and 50 - 53 and 55)** that is registered or eligible for registration on the Irish Draught or Irish Draught Sport Horse Register (ID Part Bred), with a minimum of 25% proven Irish Draught breeding, will qualify for the final of the IDHS (GB) £2,000 Challenge. Horses in **Classes 19 - 26 and 36, 37, 38 and 55** need not be registered with / over-stamped by the IDHS (GB) to qualify but **must be** on the IDHS (GB) Registers by the time of the Championship. In the final, the Champion will be awarded £1,000 prize money, the Reserve Champion will be awarded £500, and 3rd to 7th inclusive will be awarded £100 each. In addition, the highest placed Pure Bred Irish Draught will receive a £100, and the highest placed Sport Horse / Part Bred will receive £50.



ROYAL INTERNATIONAL HORSE SHOW CLASSES – GENERAL RULES

These classes are qualifiers for The Agria Royal International Horse Show. The two highest placed horses will qualify, no horse lower than 2nd will qualify. In Working Hunter classes the two highest placed horses from each class will go through to the Working Hunter Championship and all these four horses will qualify for RIHS if they have not already done so. RIHS Qualification will not pass down the line beyond the aforementioned placings. In the Working Hunter Championship, Judges must place all horses to determine qualification.

Only horses registered with SHB (GB) and who are also registered on the current year's Show Hunter Register are eligible to enter in Qualifying Classes for RIHS Ridden and Working Hunter Championships and the Show Hunter Registration Number must be quoted on entries. Any horse that is entered for a Qualifying Class without first being on the Show Hunter Register cannot subsequently be registered and therefore will not be eligible for entry in that class on the day and will be disqualified if forward.

DAY TICKETS - Competitors may compete on a day ticket and may have a maximum of two Day Tickets per season. Each day ticket is valid for the entirety of the show (this covers all SHB(GB) Classes that require a membership and registration) and it covers owner and rider membership together with horse registration/over-stamp for that show. As a qualifying class for RIHS in order for the qualification to be valid, application for full owner/rider membership and horse registration/ over-stamp must be received in the SHB(GB) office within 14 days.

CLASS 19 RIHS LADIES HUNTER

Mare or Gelding, four years old or over, ex 148cm, to be ridden by a lady side-saddle. This class is a qualifying class for the RIHS 2025 and only horses registered on the SHB(GB) Show Hunter Register are eligible to enter. Owners and Riders must be members of the SHB(GB). The two highest placed horses will qualify to enter at the RIHS.

This class is also a qualifying class for the SUPREME SHB(GB) OPEN LADIES HUNTER to be held at The National Supreme Hunter Championship 12th-13th August 2025. Horses placed 1st to 3rd will qualify.

CLASS 20 SHB(GB) NOVICE HUNTER

Mare or gelding four years old and over exceeding 148cm, not having won three affiliated Novice classes or three affiliated Open classes (excepting Working and Ladies classes) before 1st January in the current year. OR, not having been placed 1-9 in ANY CLASS (excepting Working, Ladies and Search for a Star) at The Royal International Horse Show OR Horse of the Year Show before 1st January in the current year. A Novice may be shown in a snaffle bridle. Horses entered in these classes must be registered (passported or over-stamped) with SHB(GB) and owners and riders must be members of SHB(GB) **or** compete on a Day Ticket.



CLASS 21 RIHS SMALL HUNTER

Mare or gelding, four years old and over, exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 158cms. Animals in ridden height restricted classes WILL NOT be required to be in possession of a JMB Height Certificate or verification of measurement to compete in RIHS or HOYS Qualifiers. However qualifying animals will need to be measured WITHIN 28 DAYS OF QUALIFICATION OR BEFORE THE FINAL, WHICHEVER IS SOONER. The valid JMB full height certificate or a valid JMB annual height certificate must be submitted to the SHB(GB) office on receipt from the JMB and prior to competing at RIHS. There are NO exceptions to this rule.

CLASS 22 RIHS LIGHTWEIGHT HUNTER

Mare or gelding, four years old and over, exceeding 148cms, capable of carrying up to 79.5kgs (12 stone 7lbs)

CLASS 23 RIHS MIDDLEWEIGHT HUNTER

Mare or gelding, four years old and over, exceeding 148cms, capable of carrying 79.5kgs (12 stone 7lbs) and not exceeding 89kgs (14 stone).

CLASS 24 RIHS HEAVYWEIGHT HUNTER

Mare or gelding, four years old and over, exceeding 148cms, capable of carrying over 89kgs (14 stone).

These classes are also qualifying classes for the SHB(GB) SUPREME RIDDEN HUNTER CHAMPIONSHIP to be held at The National Supreme Hunter Championship 12th-13th August 2025. Horses placed 1st to 3rd in each section will qualify.

RIHS RIDDEN HUNTER CHAMPIONSHIP for 1st & 2nd placed horses from Classes 19, 21, 22, 23 and 24

CLASS 25 RIHS AMATEUR LIGHTWEIGHT HUNTER - Mare or gelding, four years old and over, exceeding 148cms, capable of carrying 79.5kgs (12 stone 7 lbs) and under. Small hunters to be included in this category.

To be ridden by an amateur (see 2025 SHB(GB) Rules & Regulations regarding Amateur Status).

CLASS 26 RIHS AMATEUR HEAVYWEIGHT HUNTER - Mare or gelding, 4 years old or over, exceeding 148cms, capable of carrying over 79.5kgs (12 stone 7 lbs). Middleweight hunters to be included in this category.

To be ridden by an amateur (see 2025 SHB(GB) Rules & Regulations regarding Amateur Status).

No mare shall take more than one award per year.


