Class 4 Mature Rider over 35 years No jumping required, judged on position, balance and effectiveness of aids rather than the horse's confirmation and paces.

Class 5: Ridden Thoroughbred Open to horses bred to race, trained, have raced or retired racehorses. ROR registered horses will be eligible for ROR League Points.

Class 6: Ridden Hunter / Riding Horse Mare or gelding ex.148 cm.

Class 7 Best Leading Rein Pony Ponies 133cm & under. Ponies to be judged on manners and suitability.

Class 8 Mountain & Moorland. Class will be split (if numbers permit) into:

M&M small breeds Exmoors, Dartmoors, Shetlands, Welsh Sec A & B.

Open to members and non-members. All competitors and grooms must adhere to VHS Rules in all circumstances. Failure to do so may result in immediate disqualification.

VHS Regional Final qualification. All competitors placed 1st to 4th in each age category will qualify for the corresponding class at VHS Regional Finals. Members must carry their cards in the ring and have their showing card signed by the judge in the ring as proof of qualification. Non-members will receive a red qualification card which can be exchanged for signed showing card when applying for VHS membership. *This MUST be done within 21 days of qualification.* It is the competitors' responsibility to present their Showing card to the judge.

Those wishing to join or renew with the Society will need to apply for this before 1st April each year or a late penalty fee of £15 will be charged.

Regional Finals are open to members only.

All competitors are eligible to enter open classes at the National Veteran Championships, to be held venue and date TBC. No qualification or membership necessary. See VHS website for schedule which is available mid-season 2024.

Rules

1. The judge's decision is final
2. No entries will be accepted without the appropriate fee
3. Correctly fitted footwear and headgear that conform to the current safety standard must be worn at all times when mounted.
4. No galloping allowed on the showground
5. Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times
6. In the event of cancellation, your entry fee will be carried over to the next Tumpy Green event. No Refunds given.
7. A vet's or doctor's certificate will be required if a withdrawal is made and request for a refund given due to the incapacity of horse or rider
8. No jewellery to be worn and long hair to be secured above collar height.
9. No horse or pony under 4 years may compete in any ridden class.
10. Stallions and colts must be adequately bitted and handled by an adult.
11. Please abide by signage and staff directions.

Tumpy Green reserve the right to alter or cancel any event and to disqualify anyone from competing if they are guilty of unseemly conduct or dangerous riding. All competitors take part entirely at their own risk and the organisers do not hold themselves responsible for any incident or damage that may occur to horse, rider, property, vehicle or spectator.
