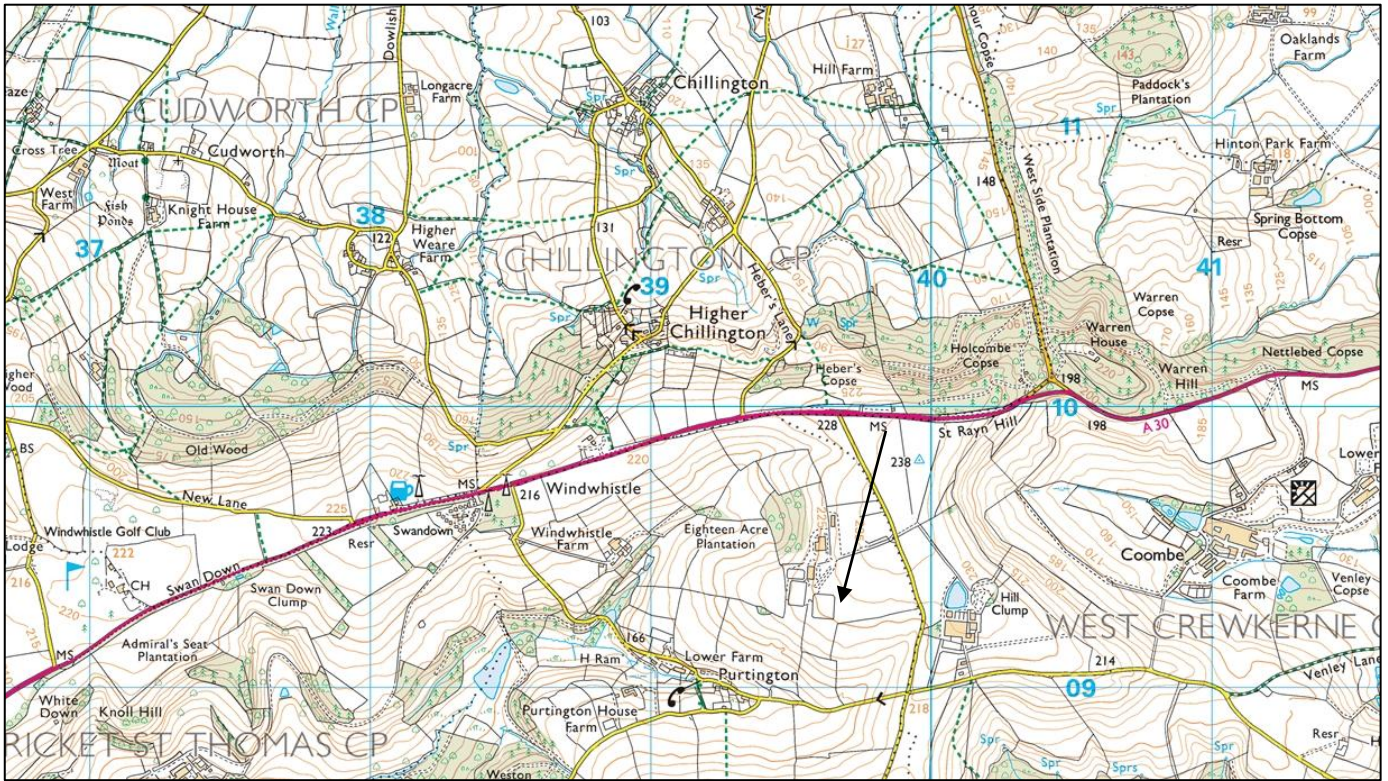

From the North

Leave M5 at Junction 25 and follow A358 to Chard. After the B&Q store traffic lights take the 1st left signposted Cricket St Thomas. At the Tesco roundabout take the A30 to Crewkerne. Follow the road for approx. 4 miles past the Cricket St Thomas Golf Club & the Windwhistle Inn.

There is a large lay-by on the left and a turning right signposted Chard Equestrian Centre and Wayford & Winsham. Turn right and after ¼ mile down the lane, the showground entrance is on your right.

From the West

Leave Exeter on the A30, after Honiton stay on the A30 towards Chard. Go straight through the town of Chard. At the Tesco roundabout take the A30 to Crewkerne. Follow the road for approx. 4 miles past the Cricket St Thomas Golf Club & the Windwhistle Inn.

There is a large lay-by on the left and a turning right signposted Chard Equestrian Centre and Wayford & Winsham. Turn right and after ¼ mile down the lane, the showground entrance is on your right.

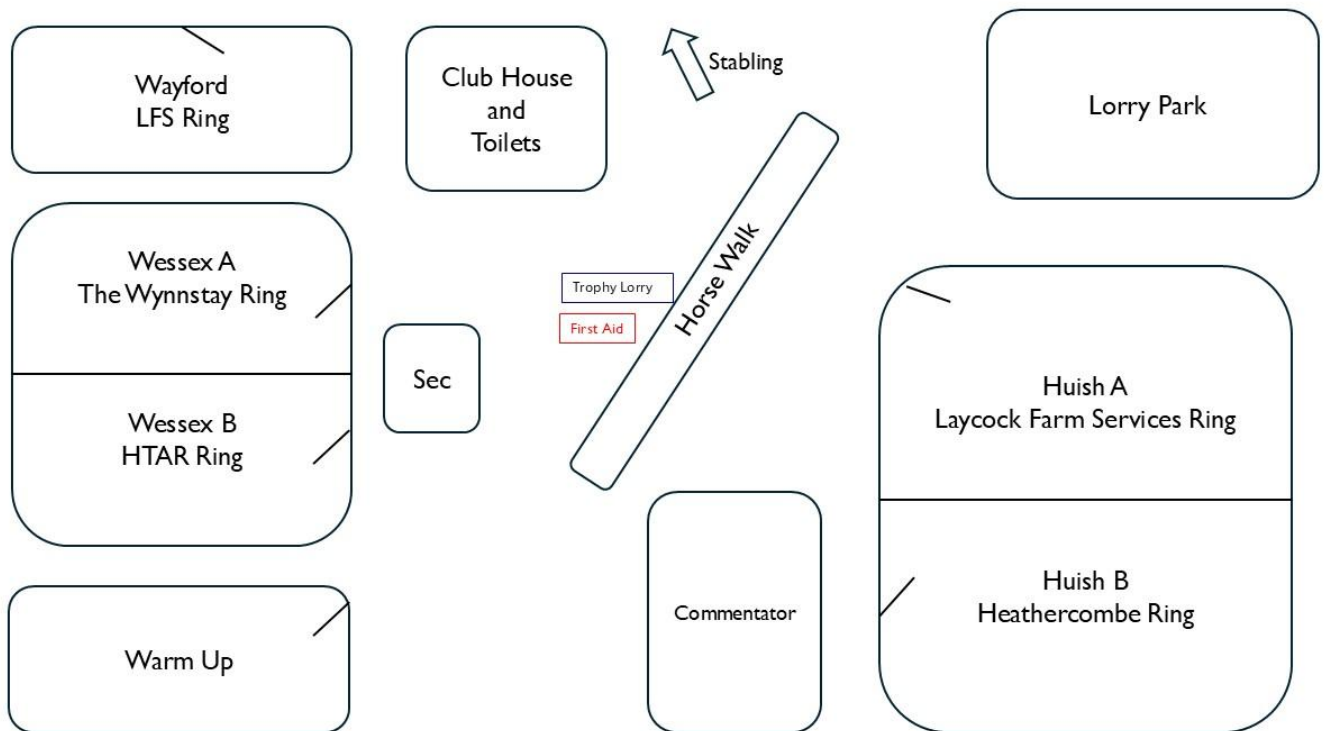
From the East

This Show is affiliated to The Coloured Horse & Pony Society (UK). **Affiliation No. 26-049**
Both owner and the rider/exhibitor need NOT be a member of CHAPS (UK) nor must the horse or pony be registered with CHAPS (UK) to compete. However, in order to qualify both owner and rider/exhibitor need to be a current showing member and have a valid qualifier card. Members to apply to CHAPS (UK) for appropriate qualifier card.

Members should apply to CHAPS UK for the appropriate Qualifier Card BEFORE COMPETING

The CHAPS (UK) Championship Show will be held on 20th – 22nd August 2026.

The following classes are CHAPS (UK) Qualifiers: 76 - 80

All stallions, 4 yrs old and over entering these classes must be graded with CHAPS (UK).

BSHA LIHS RISING STAR QUALIFIERS



LIHS BSHA SHOWING SERIES RULES FOR 2026

Competitors and horses must hold a minimum of LIHS Qualifier-Eligible Membership/ Horse Registration with the Association to be eligible to compete in the LIHS BSHA Showing series. Any competitor who qualifies for a LIHS Showing Series Supreme Final, must then complete full LIHS Qualified registration within 14 days of qualification for their qualification to stand, or it will pass to the next eligible exhibit (the nominal cost of Qualifier-Eligible membership will be taken off the cost of Full LIHS registration). Any competitors/ horses which have existing BSHA membership/ registration for 2026 will not be required to complete any LIHS Membership / Registration for these classes.

Please Note: Rising Star Amateur Rules 2026 are separate from BSHA Amateur rules. Please see the separate Rising Star Rulebook in the Rising Star section available on the BSHA website. <https://britishshowhorse.org/bsha-rising-stars-series/>

If you are in any doubt regarding your Rising Star Amateur status, please contact the BSHA Office directly, to have your status confirmed.

Classes 31, 32 and 33 will qualify for the BSHA Associate Rising Star Series Finals at the BSHA National Championships Show in September.

No BSHA Membership is required to enter these classes. The two highest placed unqualified horses in each qualifying class will be eligible to compete in the BSHA Associate Rising Star Final at the BSHA National Championship Show.

QUALIFIERS FOR FINALS AT LONDON INTERNATIONAL HORSE SHOW

(LIHS 16th – 20th December 2026)

Classes 34, 35 and 36 qualify for LIHS BSHA Rising Star Supreme Finals at the London International Horse Show.

The highest placed exhibit unqualified in top five to qualify.

A results points table will run for all qualifying classes and a 'wild card' will be awarded to those unqualified with the highest points in each section following the final qualifier.

The Judge will **NOT** ride exhibits in these classes or at the Finals.



Concours d'Elegance Society of GB

Class 72 is affiliated to the Concours d'Elegance Society of GB and is a qualifier for their Championship Show at Onley Grounds Equestrian Complex, Rugby, Warwickshire on Friday 25th and Saturday 26th September 2026



TFSS – The Friendly Showing Society

Rules, Eligibility and Qualifying Classes

All TFSS-affiliated classes at this show are run under The Friendly Showing Society (TFSS) Official Rulebook (v1.0, effective from 20 January 2026).

By entering, all competitors confirm that they have read, understood, and agree to abide by the TFSS Rules and the conditions set out in this schedule. The TFSS Rulebook applies in full unless otherwise stated within this schedule. In all matters of welfare, safety, eligibility, and conduct, TFSS Rules take precedence.

TFSS Qualifying Classes The following classes may be offered as TFSS qualifiers, in-hand and/or ridden, where approved. Only those classes formally approved by TFSS may be run as qualifying classes at this show. Classes may include, but are not limited to: ● Open Cob ● Open Coloured Horse or Pony ● Open Riding Horse / Hack ● Open Hunter ● Open Mountain and Moorland ● Veteran Horse or Pony

Specific class conditions will be stated in the individual class descriptions

Qualification

- 1st place qualifies
- 2nd place qualifies only if 1st has already qualified
- Qualifications do not automatically pass down the line
- Qualification may be withheld if, in the Judge's opinion, the required standard has not been met
- Qualification is horse or pony specific and not transferable

The Judge's decision is final.

It is the competitor's responsibility to ensure that qualification cards are correctly completed, signed, and dated by the Judge, and that a clear copy of the horse or pony's passport identification page is submitted in accordance with TFSS instructions. TFSS accepts no responsibility for missing, incomplete, or incorrectly submitted documentation.

Horse Welfare

Horse welfare is the overriding principle at all TFSS-affiliated competitions.

The Judge, Steward, or Show Officials reserve the right to:

- Inspect tack, bits, spurs, and equipment at any time
- Eliminate competitors where welfare or safety is compromised
- Refuse entry to, or remove, any horse or pony deemed unfit, distressed, lame, exhausted, or unsafe

In the interests of safety and welfare, any fall of horse, rider, or handler will result in immediate disqualification. The Judge's decision is final.

Eligibility

- Horses and ponies must be four years old or over to compete in both in-hand and ridden classes
 - Stallions are permitted unless otherwise stated in the schedule and must be correctly registered and handled or ridden by a competent adult
 - Junior competitors may not ride or handle stallions
- Any additional eligibility requirements will be stated in the individual class description.

Tack and Equipment

All tack must be safe, correctly fitted, and appropriate to the class. Training aids are not permitted in the competition ring. Any tack, bit, or equipment deemed inappropriate by the Judge or Steward may be prohibited.

Judges and Stewards

All Judges officiating at TFSS qualifying classes must be members of the TFSS Approved Judges Panel. Stewards act on behalf of TFSS and have authority to enforce the Rules in the interests of welfare and safety. All judging decisions are final.

Conduct, Behaviour and Social Media

Abuse of horses, officials, judges, stewards, volunteers, or competitors will not be tolerated. Unsporting behaviour, including defamatory, abusive, or inflammatory comments made online by competitors or their associates acting on their behalf, which are likely to bring TFSS, its officials, or its competitions into disrepute, may be treated as a breach of TFSS Rules. TFSS reserves the right to issue warnings, eliminate competitors, withdraw qualification, or refuse future participation.

Insurance and Liability

All competitors enter and compete entirely at their own risk. By running TFSS qualifying classes, the organising show confirms that it holds valid public liability insurance. Neither TFSS nor the Show Organisers accept responsibility for any loss, damage, injury, accident, or illness however caused.

IRISH DRAUGHT HORSE SOCIETY (GB)



GENERAL ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- This show is affiliated to the Irish Draught Horse Society (GB) and as such all exhibitors in **Classes 37 - 53** must be eligible under the below criteria:
- All horses must be **registered with or over-stamped** by the IDHS (GB) and in the correct ownership (except Class 54)
- Owners of Pure Bred Irish Draughts **and** Irish Draught Sport Horse (Part Bred) must be full members of the IDHS (GB) to compete
- Irish Draught Sport Horse (Part Breds) are horses that have a minimum of 25% proven Irish Draught breeding
- Ridden horses must be 153cm (15hh) or over.

In hand breeding classes

- MARES with foals at foot, 3 years and over must be inspected and classified as Class 1 (or RID), Class 2 or Supplementary Grade Up (or AID)
- Pure Bred youngstock must be the progeny of an inspected Mare (Class 1, Class 2, RID (GB), AID or Supplementary Grade Up Register) and be by a Class 1, 2 or RID (GB) stallion on the Irish Draught Breed Register.
- Pure Bred ID and ID Sport Horse (Part Bred), 3 year old colts must be un-inspected
- All 1, 2 & 3 year old colts must be bitted and shown by an experienced handler over 18 years of age
- All Pure Bred Irish Draught Stallions must be inspected and over stamped by the IDHS (GB) and be Class 1, 2 or RID (GB). Stallions must display a red, white and blue ribbon in their tails and be shown by an experienced rider/handler over 18 years of age

GENERAL QUALIFIER INFORMATION

The Finals of all IDHS (GB) qualifiers will be held at the IDHS (GB) National Championship Show on 5th & 6th September 2026 at Pickering Grange Equestrian, Pickering Grange Farm, Ellistown, Terrance Road, Coalville, LE67 1EZ.

All owners of qualified horses will be contacted by a member of the IDHS (GB) Show Affiliation Team.

Horses can only qualify for a specific Final once, regardless of the type or number of classes won, placed in or entered





IRISH DRAUGHT HORSE SOCIETY (GB)



Ridden Irish Draught & Irish Draught Sport Horse (Part Bred) £2,000 Ridden Challenge

This show is a qualifier for the £2,000 Ridden Challenge jointly sponsored by the IDHS (GB) and Yorkshire Irish Draught & Hunter Show. The highest placed Pure Bred and Part Bred (not already qualified) from **Classes 49, 50, 51, 52 and 54** will qualify for the final. In the final, the Champion will be awarded £1,000 prize money, the Reserve Champion will be awarded £500 and 3rd to 7th inclusive will be awarded £100 each. In addition, the highest placed Pure Bred Irish Draught will receive £100, and the highest placed Irish Draught Part Bred will receive £50.

SHBGB Classes

Shows affiliated to the SHB (GB) and /or the BSHA, can also hold qualifiers for the £2000 Ridden Challenge in the following:

Ridden Hunters (All weights, Smalls, Novice, Amateur & Ladies) * **Classes 21 – 28 are qualifiers**

Cobs (All weights, Maxi Cob, Novice, Amateurs, Working Cob)

Working Hunters (Novice, Open, Amateurs)

Riding Horse (Small, Large, Novice & Amateur)

To qualify, a horse must follow the same eligibility criteria as for both Irish Draught & Irish Draught Sport Horse (Part Bred) but horses **need not be registered with / over stamped by the IDHS (GB) to qualify** but **must be** on the appropriate Register or over stamped by the IDHS (GB) and the owner be a full member of the Society by the time of the Championship.

The Irish Draught Owners & Breeders Group Youngstock Challenge

This show is a Qualifier for The Irish Draught Owners & Breeders Group Youngstock Challenge.

The two highest placed Pure-Breds from each age group not already qualified in **Class 41** will qualify. If one or both have already qualified, the horse next in line in each age group will qualify. Horses entered into this class must be eligible under the criteria listed on **Page 11** of this schedule. At the final, there will be three preliminary classes with the two highest placed semi-finalists from each class going forward to the Championship. The Champion will receive £500 and the Reserve Champion £150.

British Horse Feeds and IDHS (GB) Ridden Championship Series 2027

This show is a qualifier for the **British Horse Feeds and IDHS (GB) Ridden Championship Series 2027**

The two highest-placed horses (not already qualified) from Classes 51 and 52 will qualify for the final to be held at the **Royal International Horse Show Hickstead on July 24th 2027**. Qualification can be passed to 3rd place if the highest-placed horses have already qualified and if, in the opinion of the judges, the exhibit is of sufficient quality.

Owners of both Pure Bred and Irish Draught Sport Horse (Part Bred) horses must be **FULL** members of the Irish Draught Horse Society (GB).

- Purebred Irish Draught horses must be registered with or over-stamped by the IDHS (GB).
- Purebred stallions must be the progeny of a graded mare (ID Class 1, ID Class 2, RID, AID, or Supplementary Grade Up) by an ID Class 1, Class 2, RID(GB) stallion and be inspected or over-stamped by the IDHS (GB) and classified as ID Class I Class 2, or RID(GB).
- Irish Draught Part Bred (Sport Horses) horses including stallions must have a minimum of 25% proven Irish Draught breeding and must be registered on the Irish Draught Sport Horse Register.

All horses must be in the correct ownership and must be 4 years and over and 153cm (15hh) or over

4. 1st – 3rd in each age group will qualify for the Senior of Year Championship

NOTE: ONCE A COMPETITOR HAS QUALIFIED FOR LIHS IN THE RIDDEN SECTION, THEY ARE NOT ALLOWED TO QUALIFY IN THE IN-HAND SECTION AND VICE VERSA.

Competitors MUST produce both the above cards at the ring side before entry NO CARDS NO ENTRY

No Spurs with the exception to senior side saddle riders. No Galloping or canter extensions, Riders/Handlers - No Wearing of Face/Body Jewelry with the exception to the earring used by competitors with health problems. Foals are NOT permitted in SSADL Classes. For In-Hand Classes - Minimum age of handler = 11 years old. First Ridden ponies/riders will be asked after the initial walk round to come into the centre of the ring. First Ridden Competitors will only canter in their individual shows.

Lead Rein & First Ridden competitors: Strip section both lead rein and First Ridden rider MUST stay mounted.

STALLIONS - Either for In Hand or Ridden classes, Competitors Must be 16 years of age or over. Competitors cannot enter the ring once the command of trot has been given. Grooms must be 16 years of age and correctly Dressed. The same rider/handler/pony/horse combination must stay the same from qualifier to Grand Finals, unless special circumstances should arise, then it will be left to the discretion of the Directors and Advisory Committee to oversee this rule if required. The same rider/handler/pony/horse combination must stay the same whether side saddle or astride from First/Second or Direct Route Qualifiers and Grand Final.

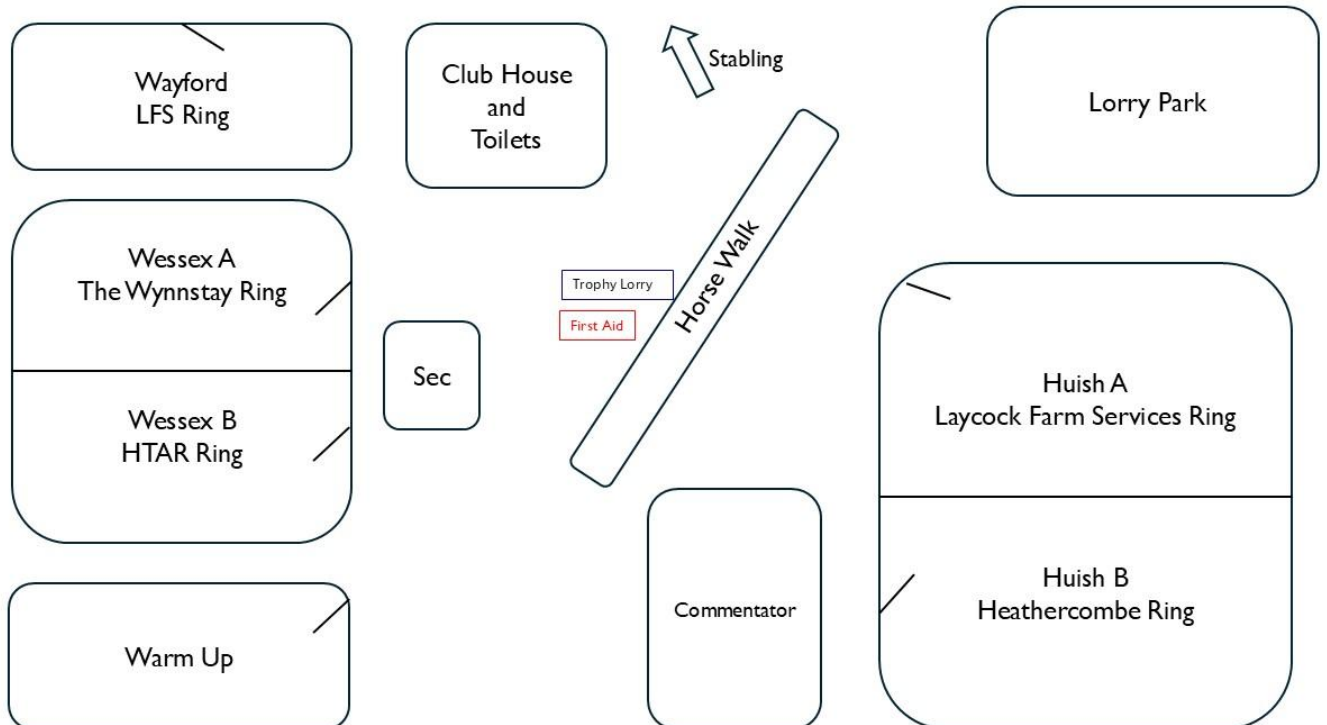

- The Organisers of this Show have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, **everyone** must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the Organisers, Officials and Stewards
- **Insurance / Health & Safety** Wessex Horse Show will be managed and risk assessed by WHS in conjunction with associated show partners, external organisations and the hosting venue. Wessex Horse Show undertakes to ensure the review and implementation of health and safety arrangements, risk management plans and appropriate venue event insurance. On an individual basis – all riders and rider connections attending Wessex Horse Show agree, as a condition of entry to have relevant and adequate insurance provision in place to cover their ridden activities and rider insurance must include third-party liability.
