3. BEST RIDER 16 Years and under, small jump to be included. (If sufficient entries this class will be divided 10 and under and 11 years and over) No lead reins.
4. FAMILY PONY 15hh and under—Short show, jump to be included, and additional tasks to suit the class.

Jumping Classes Single Phase—second half of course timed

1. Mini cross poles—leading rein or assisted
2. 40cm - - leading rein or assisted.
3. **Horse and Hound Jumping.** Fences approx. 40/45 m ponies any height. (Rider on pony jumps half a round, gets off and runs over second half of course with dog . Timed.) Seconds added if rider assisted.
4. 50 cm— assisted but not led
5. 60 cm— no assistance
6. 70 cm— no assistance

Rosettes to sixth place.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

The judges decision is final.

1. Ages on day of the show.
2. The organisers reserve the right to refuse entry or to delete or alter the programme in any way they might think necessary.
3. Cantering is not allowed on the site except when required in the show ring.
4. Hard hats/scull caps to BHS standards with chin strap securely fastened, correct footwear to be worn when mounted.
5. No horse or pony under 3 yrs to be entered in any ridden class
6. No whips or spurs are allowed in the Gymkhana classes. Any competitor ill-treating their animal will be asked to leave the showground.
7. The organisers and the owners of the land accept no responsibility whatsoever for any loss, damage, or injury to any person, animal or property on the show ground, the car parks or their approaches
8. It is a condition of entry that all attendees shall indemnify the show and its officials against all actions, proceedings, claims etc in relation to, or arising out of his or her entry in the show.
9. All entrants will be responsible for the behaviour, conduct and competence of their assistants or riders. All entrants shall be subject to the orders of the Stewards and Judges.
10. It is the responsibility of all Competitors to ensure that they are on time for their class. Check the schedule for possible timing clashes as no refunds will be given.
