## **Rules & Conditions of Entry**

### **The Heels Down Club Open Show**

- By attending or competing at The Heels Down Club Open Show, all competitors, spectators, owners, and handlers agree to abide by the following rules and conditions.
- The Heels Down Club and the organisers accept no responsibility for any accident, injury, illness, loss, or damage to any person, horse, pony, vehicle, property, or equipment howsoever caused. Attendance and participation are entirely at your own risk.
- All horses and ponies must be handled in a safe and responsible manner at all times.
- All dogs must be kept on a lead at all times whilst on the showground.
- Rider ages apply as of 1st January of the current year.
- All ridden horses and ponies must be 4 years old or over.
- All horses and ponies attending the show must hold a valid passport, which must be available for inspection if requested by the organisers.
- Excessive or inappropriate use of whips or spurs will not be tolerated and may result in elimination and removal from the showground without refund.
- Whips must not exceed 75cm (30 inches) in length.
- Entry fees are non-refundable once entries have been submitted.
- Any complaints or objections must be made in writing to the Show Secretary within 10 minutes of the close of the relevant class and accompanied by a £10 deposit, refundable only if the complaint is upheld.
- Correct riding attire must be worn at all times.
- All mounted riders must wear correctly fitted and fastened approved riding hats compliant with current BHS safety standards.
- The decision of the judges and show organisers is final.
- No entries will be accepted once a class has commenced, except at the discretion of the organisers in exceptional circumstances.
- The organisers reserve the right to refuse entries, alter, amalgamate, divide, or cancel classes where necessary.
- The organisers reserve the right to refuse admission or entry without explanation.
- Spectators are reminded that horses and ponies can be unpredictable. Please take care at all times, especially with children and non-horsey visitors.
- Anyone behaving in an unsafe, abusive, or inappropriate manner may be asked to leave the venue.
- All competitors are responsible for ensuring they hold appropriate third-party liability insurance for both horse and rider.
- Competitors and attendees are expected to conduct themselves in a safe and respectful manner throughout the event.
- Pre-entries only. Pre-entered competitors may be permitted to enter additional classes on the day.
